Proposed Plan Environmental Commitment Plan Note:

The project is located in the Corridor Management Zone for the Henry County Regional Water & Sewer District's McClure drinking water resource area. In order to minimize the potential for a release in this sensitive area, project related refueling and maintenance activities shall not be performed within the project area. Spills of fuels, oils, chemicals or other materials which could pose a threat to the drinking water source area shall be cleaned up immediately by the Contractor. If the spill is a reportable amount, the Contractor shall contact City of Napoleon Fire Chief, Clayton O'Brien at (419) 592-0441 for clean up of the spill; as well as the Local Emergency Planning Committee (LEPC) Director, Nick Nye at (419) 599-5827; and the local Emergency Management Agency (EMA) Director, Tracy Busch at (419) 599-6432.

Hi Nick,

I hope you are doing well!

The reason for my email is that Mannik & Smith Group, Inc. (MSG) is currently working on the environmental document for the Henry County TID for the New Maumee River Crossing proposed for the extension of Industrial Drive in Napoleon that will cross over the river and extend to SR110 near Campbell's Soup (see attached map). As you can see on the attached map, the project location is within the western edge of the Henry County Regional Water & Sewer District's McClure drinking water protection service area.

It is my understanding that you are the contact person to coordinate construction projects for the drinking water protection service area. If this is no longer the case, please direct me to the contact person I need to coordinate with for this project.

We propose having the following environmental commitment note in the plans for the eventual contractor for the project, to protect the Maumee River watershed from accidental spills of hazardous materials should such an incident occur.

Proposed Plan Environmental Commitment Plan Note:

The project is located in the Corridor Management Zone for the Henry County Regional Water & Sewer District's McClure drinking water resource area. In order to minimize the potential for a release in this sensitive area, project related refueling and maintenance activities shall not be performed within the project area. Spills of fuels, oils, chemicals or other materials which could pose a threat to the drinking water source area shall be cleaned up immediately by the Contractor. If the spill is a reportable amount, the Contractor should contact City of Napoleon Fire Chief, Clayton O'Brien at (419) 592-0441 for clean up of the spill.

Please let me know if the above plan note would be adequate to address the protection of the drinking water protection service area. If there is further coordination needed, please indicate what additional coordination we need to do for the environmental document and project. Otherwise, if this proposed plan note above is adequate, please indicate this will satisfy the coordination needs.

Thanks in advance for your assistance on this coordination effort, it is greatly appreciated.


