Notice is hereby given that sealed bids will be received by the Board of County Commissioners of Henry County, Ohio at the office of its Clerk, Henry County Commissioners, until the 13th day of January, 2009 at 10:00 o'clock A.M., at which time and place, said bids will be opened and read for 15,000 tons, more or less, of crushed limestone for use by the Henry County Highway Department according to the specifications for the same which are on file with said Clerk, 1853 Oakwood Avenue, Napoleon, Ohio. A copy of the same may be obtained between the hours of 8:30 A.M. and 4:30 P.M., Monday through Friday.

Bids must be submitted on the forms provided by the Engineer.

Bids may be hand delivered or mailed in a sealed envelope bearing the Bidder's name and address and marked "Sealed Bid for Crushed Limestone".

The said Board reserves the right to reject any or all bids.

The contract will be award to the lowest and best bidder.

No bid will be considered unless it be accompanied by a bond executed by a surety company authorized to do business in the State of Ohio or a certified check on a solvent bank; either in the amount of five (5%) percent of the bid based on furnishing 5,000 tons of Washed No. 8 stone to guarantee that if said bid is accepted, a contract will be entered into and the performance of it properly secured.

SCOPE

The Henry County Engineer is seeking bids for crushed limestone to be used by the Henry County Highway Department for various maintenance operations during 2009. The primary aggregates used are Washed No. 8 and No. 411.

Washed No. 8 and No. 411 aggregates constitute approximately 60% of total usage.

During 2008 the Henry County Highway Department used approximately 15,000 tons of aggregate.

SPECIFICATIONS

The purpose of these specifications is to provide Henry County Highway Department with various grades of crushed limestone aggregate meeting the requirements of the 2005 State of Ohio, Department of Transportation Construction and Materials Specifications.

A primary consideration of the bidder shall be the Henry County Highway Department's need of approximately 5,000 tons of Washed No. 8 aggregate for use in the seal coating of County roads. Multiple awards may be made for various types of limestone being bid.

Quotations are requested for No.'s 1, 2, 8, washed No. 8, 9, washed No. 9, 57, 304, 310, 411, 601D, 601A, B, C, 617, Sand and, special O.S. Rip-Rap, 4" - 10" gradation with no fines, F.O.B. Henry County trucks at the quarry. Award of contract shall be conditioned in part upon the Engineer's cost of transporting stone from quarry to work site and/or County stockpile. The actual County Highway Department purchases of stone may be more or less, depending upon the various highway maintenance requirements,

PRICE BID - The price bid for crushed limestone aggregate shall be the unit price per ton, F.O.B. Henry County trucks at the quarry and shall be effective from February 1, 2009 through January 31, 2010.

PROOF OF INSURANCE

Vendors are required to furnish the County with a certificate of insurance in the minimum amount of \$1,000,000.00 primary and \$1,000,000.00 umbrella coverage. The County, its elected office and employees shall be named as additional insureds with respect to all activities under any agreement resulting from this bidding. The certificate of insurance shall provide that such insurance shall not be cancelled without thirty (30) days prior written notice to the County. Vendors will replace certificate for any insurance expiring prior to the effective end date under any agreement resulting from this bidding.

WORKER'S COMPENSATION

Vendors shall maintain Worker's Compensation coverage as required by Ohio law. A copy of a valid Worker's Compensation certificate shall be submitted with the bid.

INDEMNIFICATION/HOLD HARMLESS

The vendor shall indemnify and hold harmless the County, its agents and employees from any and all losses, claims, damages, lawsuits, costs, judgments, expenses or any other liabilities which they may incur as a result of bodily injury, sickness, disease or death, or injury to or destruction of tangible property including the loss of use resulting therefrom, caused in whole or part by the negligent act or omission of the vendor or any person directly or indirectly employed by any of them or any person for whose acts any of them may be liable.

VERIFICATION OF "NO FINDING FOR RECOVERY"

No political subdivision shall award a contract for goods, services, or construction to a person against whom a Finding for Recovery has been issued by the Auditor of State, if the Finding for Recovery is unresolved.

The undersigned, by their signature and title, document that no "Finding for Recovery" is outstanding for the bidder.

The Pre-certification form (HLS 0035) should only be completed if you are specifically instructed to do so by the agency or office requesting the form.
