NOTICE TO CONTRACTORS

Sealed proposals will be received at the Office of the Ridgeville Township Fiscal Officer, 20-601 US 6, Ridgeville Corners, Ohio until Monday, August 2, 2010 at 8:00 P.M. for the improvement of the following Township roads:

- a) Road U from State Route 66 to State Route 34
- b) Road 22 from Road S to Road U1
- c) Road U1 from Road 21a to Road 22
- d) Road 21 from US 6 to Road U
- e) Road X from US 6 to Road S
- f) Road 20a from US 6 to Road S
- g) Road T from Road X to Road 19
- h) Quality Drive

Ridgeville Township, Henry County, Ohio, in accordance with estimates and specifications on file with the Ridgeville Township Fiscal Officer.

Bids are to be submitted on a unit price basis.

The contracts will be awarded to the lowest, competent and responsible bidder.

Each bidder is required to file with his bid a bid guaranty in the form of either:

1. A bond for the full amount of the bid; or
2. A certified check, cashier's check or letter of credit pursuant to Chapter 1305 of the Ohio Revised Code, in the amount of ten (10%) percent of the bid price as guarantee that, if the contract be awarded on such bid, the bidder will enter into a contract and the performance of it will be properly secured.

The successful bidder, if using a (10%) bid guaranty, shall be required to provide a contract performance and payment bond for the full amount of the bid.

Estimated cost of the improvements is \$34,965.00

Prevailing Wage Rates per Section 4115 of the Ohio Revised Code shall prevail on this project.

The Board of Trustees reserves the right to award separate contracts for the above noted improvements. The Board of Trustees reserves the right to reject any or all bids.

Crackseal Various Township Roads

Ohio Department of Transportation Construction and Material Specifications dated January 1, 2008 shall apply. Work shall consist of preparation and sealing of pavement cracks or joints with hot applied crack sealant in accordance with ODOT Item 423, Crack sealing, hot applied, Type I.

Material shall be applied flush with existing pavement. If excess material is applied, a squeegee shall be used to level the material.

The contractor shall sand finish as directed by the Township Trustees to prevent tracking.

Prevailing Wage Rates per Section 4115 of the Ohio Revised Code shall prevail on this project. A copy of the applicable wage rates may be obtained from the State of Ohio Wage and Hour Division via the internet at the following web site:

Should the bidder not have access to the internet, a complete set of the applicable wage rates are available at the office of the Henry County Engineer. A copy will be provided if requested.

The successful bidder will be provided a hard copy of the prevailing wage rate as a part of the contract documents.

Any rate changes received from the State Wage and Hour Division during the term of the contract will be provided in hard copy to the Contractor.

Contractors are required to furnish the Township with a certificate of insurance in the minimum amount of \$1,000,000.00 primary and \$1,000,000.00 umbrella coverage. The Township, its elected office and employees shall be named as additional insured with respect to all activities under any agreement resulting from this bidding. The certificate of insurance shall provide that such insurance shall not be cancelled without thirty (30) days prior written notice to the Township. Contractors will replace certificate for any insurance expiring prior to the effective end date under any agreement resulting from this bidding.

Contractors shall maintain Worker's Compensation coverage as required by Ohio law. A copy of a valid Worker's Compensation certificate shall be submitted with the bid.

The Contractor shall indemnify and hold harmless the Township, its agents and employees from any and all losses, claims, damages, lawsuits, costs, judgments, expenses or any other liabilities which they may incur as a result of bodily injury, sickness, disease or death, or injury to or destruction of tangible property including the loss of use resulting therefrom, caused in whole or part by the negligent act or omission of the Contractor or any person directly or indirectly employed by any of them or any person for whose act any of them may be liable.

Accompanying this proposal is a bid guaranty in the form of either:

- 1) A bond for the full amount of the bid, on the above improvement; or
- 2) A certified check, cashier's check or letter of credit pursuant to Chapter 1305 of the Ohio Revised Code, in the amount of ten percent (10%) of the bid on the above improvements, payable to the order of the Board of Trustees, RIDGEVILLE TOWNSHIP, which check or bond is to be forfeited if, in case this proposal is accepted, the undersigned shall fail to execute a contract within ten (10) days of Notice of Award.

This contract shall be under the direct supervision of the Ridgeville Township Trustees and the Henry County Engineer.

All items are approximate, and final measurement of completed items will govern final payment.

In the event of discrepancy between the unit and total price bid, the unit price shall prevail. The unit prices shall remain in effect and held firm for the term of this contract. ODOT Item 401.20 Asphalt Binder price adjustment does not apply.

The Contractor shall be responsible for all construction one (1) year after project completion and acceptance. The Contractor shall make all corrections as necessary by reason of noted defects. The Trustees will give notice of observed defects with reasonable promptness. In the event that the Contractor fails to make repairs, adjustments or complete other work which may be required by such defects, the Trustees may do so and charge the Contractor the costs incurred.

The Board of Trustees reserves the right to award separate contracts on the various roads described. The Board of Trustees further reserves the right to reject any or all bids.

The work shall be completed on or before October 1, 2010.

For each calendar day that any work shall remain uncompleted after the stated completion date the appropriate sum, in accordance with the schedule of liquidated damages per Section 108.07 of the Standard Specifications of the State of Ohio Department of Transportation, will be deducted from any monies due the Contractor, not as a penalty but as liquidated damages; provided however, that due account shall be taken of any adjustment of the completion date granted by the Board of Trustees of Ridgeville Township.

A work day will be counted as lost if the Contractor's efficiency is reduced more than fifty (50%) percent on the critical items under construction at that time. Weekends and holidays will not be counted as lost work days.
