SECTION B: Chipseal Various Township Roads

For Township Road 16B a layer of ODOT Spec. 408 Prime Coat shall be applied at the rate provided in the attached Napoleon Township Engineer’s Estimate to the cement stabilization prior to chip seal. The Prime Coat must cure for at least 24 hours prior to the commencement of chipseal operations. After the 24 hour wait the contractor may apply the first chip seal. Wait at least 18 hours before placing the second course of chip seal. Ensure that the first course meets the specifications and is cured, swept and capable of withstanding construction traffic without damage. Work on Township Road 16B cannot be performed until the paving contractor completes the cement stabilization. Once cement stabilization is complete the winning chipseal contractor will be notified of the completion and is required to complete the Township Road 16B chipseal job within 45 days after notification. The quantities for Township Road 16B will be as follows:

Prevailing Wage Rates per Section 4115 of the Ohio Revised Code shall prevail on this project. A copy of the applicable wage rates may be obtained from the State of Ohio Wage and Hour Division via the internet at the following web site:

Should the bidder not have access to the internet, a complete set of the applicable wage rates are available at the office of the Henry County Engineer. A copy will be provided if requested.

The successful bidder will be provided a hard copy of the prevailing wage rate as a part of the contract documents.

Any rate changes received from the State Wage and Hour Division during the term of the contract will be provided in hard copy to the Contractor.

Contractors are required to furnish the Township with a certificate of insurance in the minimum amount of \$1,000,000.00 primary and \$1,000,000.00 umbrella coverage. The Township, its elected office and employees shall be named as additional insured with respect to all activities under any agreement resulting from this bidding. The certificate of insurance shall provide that such insurance shall not be cancelled without thirty (30) days prior written notice to the Township. Contractors will replace certificate for any insurance expiring prior to the effective end date under any agreement resulting from this bidding.

Contractors shall maintain Worker’s Compensation coverage as required by Ohio law. A copy of a valid Worker’s Compensation certificate shall be submitted with the bid.

The Contractor shall indemnify and hold harmless the Township, its agents and employees from any and all losses, claims, damages, lawsuits, costs, judgments, expenses or any other liabilities which they may incur as a result of bodily injury, sickness, disease or death, or injury to or destruction of tangible property including the loss of use resulting therefrom, caused in whole or part by the negligent act or omission of the Contractor or any person directly or indirectly employed by any of them or any person for whose act any of them may be liable.

Accompanying this proposal is a bid guaranty in the form of either:

- 1) A bond for the full amount of the bid, on the above improvement; or

2) A certified check, cashier's check or letter of credit pursuant to Chapter 1305 of the Ohio Revised Code, in the amount of ten percent (10%) of the bid on the above improvements, payable to the order of the Board of Trustees, NAPOLEON TOWNSHIP, which check or bond is to be forfeited if, in case this proposal is accepted, the undersigned shall fail to execute a contract within ten (10) days of Notice of Award.

This contract shall be under the direct supervision of the Napoleon Township Trustees.

All items are approximate, and final measurement of completed items will govern final payment.

In the event of discrepancy between the unit and total price bid, the unit price shall prevail. The unit prices shall remain in effect and held firm for the term of this contract.

The Contractor shall be responsible for all construction one (1) year after project completion and acceptance. The Contractor shall make all corrections as necessary by reason of noted defects. The Trustees will give notice of observed defects with reasonable promptness. In the event that the Contractor fails to make repairs, adjustments or complete other work which may be required by such defects, the Trustees may do so and charge the Contractor the costs incurred.

The Board of Trustees reserves the right to reject any or all bids.

The chipseal work shall be completed on or before September 1, 2012.

For each calendar day that any work shall remain uncompleted after the stated completion date the appropriate sum, in accordance with the schedule of liquidated damages per Section 108.07 of the Standard Specifications of the State of Ohio Department of Transportation, will be deducted from any monies due the Contractor, not as a penalty but as liquidated damages; provided however, that due account shall be taken of any adjustment of the completion date granted by the Board of Trustees of Napoleon Township.

A work day will be counted as lost if the Contractor's efficiency is reduced more than fifty (50%) percent on the critical items under construction at that time. Weekends and holidays will not be counted as lost work days.

- ITEM 409 SEAL COAT SHALL BE APPLIED BY THE CONTRACTOR PER (1997) O.D.O.T. CONSTRUCTION AND MATERIAL SPECIFICATIONS, WITH THE BELOW EXCEPTIONS.
 - ITEM 409 SEAL COAT COVER AGGREGATE SHALL BE PAID BY THE TON RATHER THAN BY THE CUBIC YARD.
 - THE CONTRACTOR SHALL BE RESPONSIBLE FOR THE ORDERING OF ALL MATERIALS.
 - ON ROADS WHICH REQUIRE TWO PASSES FOR COVERAGE, SUFFICIENT TIME SHALL PASS BEFORE THE JOINT IS SWEEP, AS DIRECTED BY THE NAPOLEON TOWNSHIP TRUSTEES.
 - ITEM 409S-BROOMING FINISHED PAVEMENT, SHALL BE PERFORMED WITHIN 24 HOURS AFTER NO. 8A AND NO. 9A SEALS HAVE BEEN COMPLETED.


