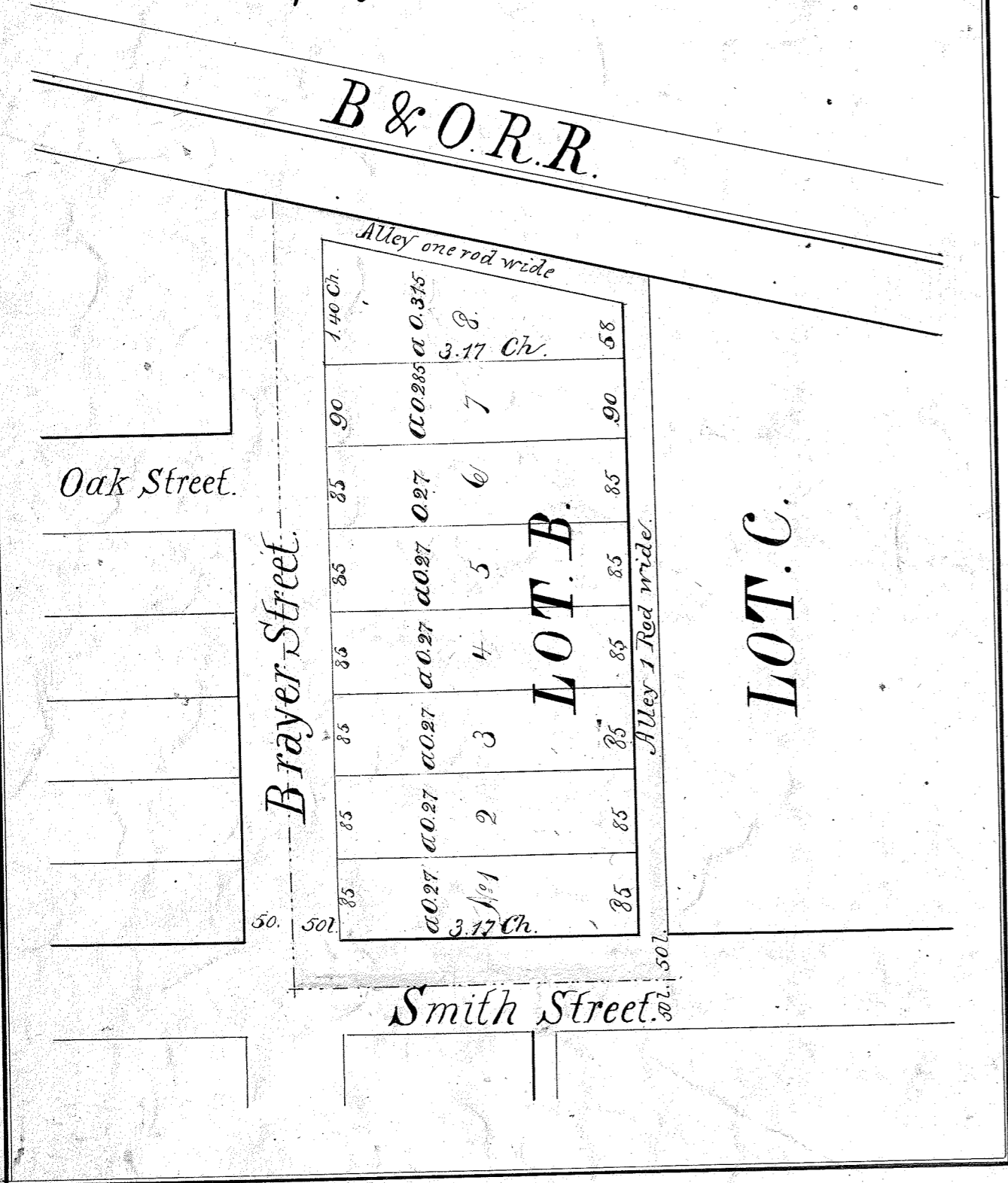


PLAT

Field Notes to the annexed Plat.

The plat is bounded and described as follows:
 Commencing at a point where the South line of the B & O R.R. crosses the center of Brayer Street in the Village of Kaufmanville; thence running south along the center of Brayer Street to the center of Smith Street a distance of 8.08 Chains; thence East along Smith Street 3.92 Chains; thence North to the South line of the B & O R.R. 7.16 Chains; thence northwesterly along said South line of B & O R.R. 4.06 Chains to the place of beginning; containing 3 acres of land, including Streets and Alleys.

The lots have been layed out and surveyed, as shown on the plat, at the request and under the instructions of the Proprietor J. H. Hornung, on the eighth day of August A.D. 1883.

The Numbers of the lots are marked on the plat in red ink. The dimensions of the respective lots, and the width of Streets and Alleys are shown on said plat in Chains and Links.

The area of land contained in each lot has been marked on the plat.

The Scale, by which the plat is drawn is 3 Chains to 2 inches.
