

Field Notes:- To the plat and survey of John Scofield's 4th Addition to the Village of Ridgenille, Henry County, Ohio, situated in the North West Corner of the South East 1/4 of the North West 1/4 of Section 35, Town Six (6) North Range five 5. East, Henry County Ohio, and bounded and described as follows: Commencing at a point in the Center of the Ridge Road 14.80 chains South and 10.10 chains N 66° 15' E of the North West Corner of the South East 1/4 of the North West 1/4 of Section 35 of said Town and Range, Thence North 672 ft. 6 in. to the Center of the Bryan Pike, Thence North Westerly along the Center of said Pike 152 feet to the quarter Section line, Thence West along said quarter Section line 237 feet, Thence South 807 feet to the Center of the Ridge Road, Thence N 66° 15' E along the Center of said Ridge Road to the place of beginning, as shown on Plat containing 7.52 acres including streets.

The name of the street is marked on the Plat. Also the width of the street in feet and inches. The lots are numbered with red ink and their dimensions are marked in feet and inches with black ink.

FIELD NOTES TO J W RUSSELL
 FIRST ADDITION TO LIBERTY CENTER O.

This addition is situated in the North East quarter of the South West quarter of Section No 25 Town Six (6) North Range Seven (7) East, Henry County Ohio, and more particularly described as follows: Beginning at a point 355 feet west of a stone at the S. E. Cor. of the N E 1/4 of the S W 1/4 of said Section No 25. Thence North 30' east 659 feet. Thence N 89° 50' W 148 feet. Thence S 30' W. 659 feet. Thence S 89° 50' E 148 feet to place of beginning, containing 2.24 acres.

This addition lies direct west of D. Lehrgood's addition and joins Garfield Street in said addition on the west. Plum Street is continued 40 feet wide along the north side of this addition and Cherry Street is continued along the south side one half width, or 25 feet. an alley 16 feet wide is located on and along the west side of this addition. The dimensions of the lots are 66 feet by 132 feet as shown on plat in black ink. Lot numbers are in red ink, two stones were planted indicated thus o on plat.

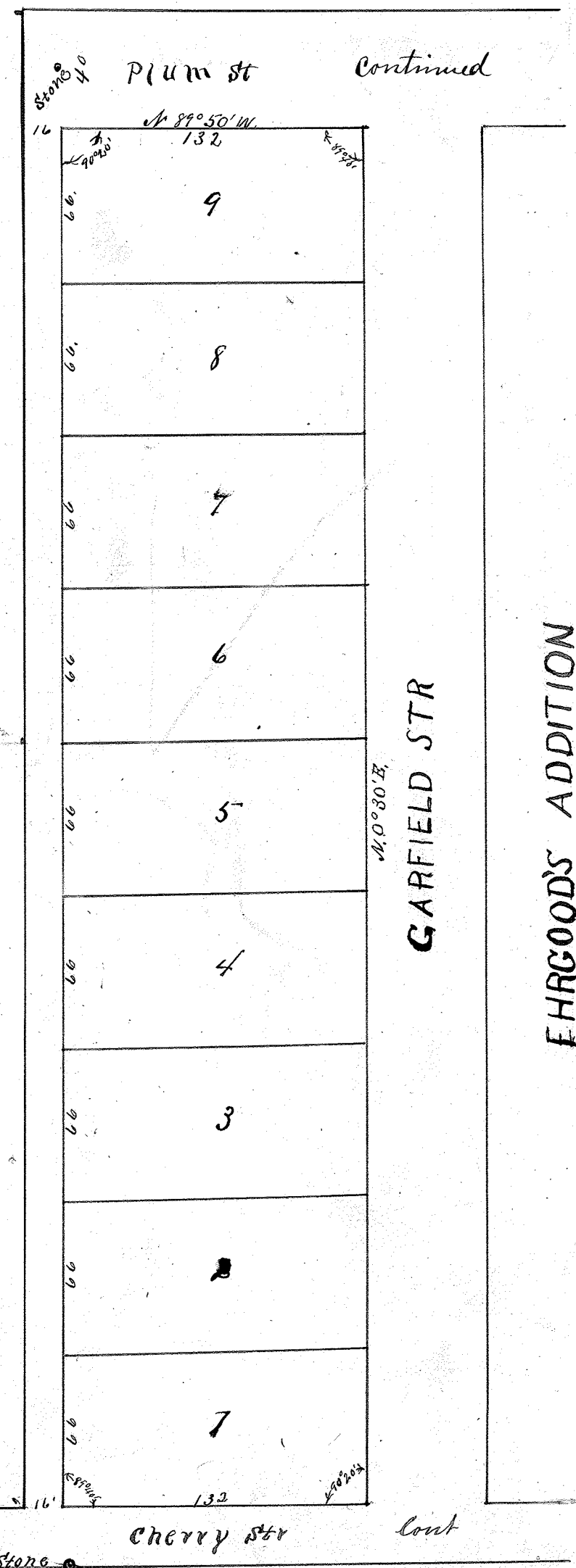
