

LEWIS MEYERS'S 1ST ADDITION TO RIDGEVILLE HENRY COUNTY OHIO.



Field Notes

Field Notes of Lewis Meyers's 1st Addition to the Village of Ridgerville, Henry County, Ohio, and described as follows: commencing at a point 581 feet East of the South West Corner of the North East 1/4 of the North West 1/4 of Section No. 35, Town Sec 16, North, Range five (5) East, Henry County, Ohio, thence East 572 feet; thence North 584 feet thence West 572 feet; thence South 584 feet to the place of beginning, containing 7.68 acres as shown on Plat.

The names of the streets are marked on the Plat; also the width of the streets and alleys in feet. The Lots are numbered with red ink and their dimensions are marked with black ink in feet. Monuments are planted as indicated on Plat.
