 four from left of your course from the street lines on.

**Plat of The Town of Napoleon, with the field notes and references to the South Addition. Surveyed March 30 1841.**

Commencing on the west side of Scott street and on the North side of Main street continued; thence  
 65 degrees west twenty rods to the east side of Webster street; thence north 27 degrees west eight rods to an alley; thence  
 same course (one rod) ac. as said alley; thence same course eight rods to the south side of Washington street contin-  
 ued; thence same course five rods to the north side of said street; thence same course ten rods to an alley; thence  
 thence same course across said alley; thence same course ten rods to the south side of Clinton street continued  
 thence north 27 degrees west twenty rods to the west side of Scott street; thence south 27 degrees ten rods to an alley; thence  
 same course one rod across said alley; thence same course ten rods to the north side of Washington street; thence same  
 course five rods to the south side of said street; thence same course eight rods to an alley; thence same course across said alley  
 thence same course eight rods to the place of beginning. Main, Washington and Clinton streets are continued to the west  
 side of Webster street. The lot numbers 64 to 63 inclusive are four rods wide and eight rods long and from 104 to 63 inclusive  
 are four rods wide and ten rods long and also a further addition. Commencing on the north side of a two rod alley  
 and on the east side of Main street; thence north 27 degrees twenty four rods to the south side of Clinton street; thence same  
 course three rods across said street to the south west corner of lot 103; thence same course two rods on a line to the east  
 side of the Indiana Napoleon and Napoleon for township; thence north 15 degrees east along the east side of said street and  
 twelve links to the south side of Depot st. thence north 65 degrees east sixteen rods to the west side of Main cross street continued  
 and the north east corner of lot 103; thence same course five rods across said street to the north west corner of lot 102; thence same  
 course two rods to an alley one rod wide and eight rods long and south west corner of lot 103; thence south 27 degrees west nine rods and six links to the  
 south east corner of lot 102 and the north side of Clinton street; thence same course three rods to the south side of said street  
 thence same course twenty same course twenty four rods to a two rod wide alley; thence south 65 degrees west along the north  
 side of said alley ten rods to the east side of Main cross street continued; thence same course five rods to the north side  
 of said street; thence same course ten rods to an alley; thence same course across said alley; thence same course  
 five rods to the place of beginning. Depot street is three rods wide and bounded on the north by the steps grounds  
 of Solids and Harmon B. Lot 103, seven rods wide on Main cross street and twenty one rods long in Clinton  
 street; lot 102 is eight rods and 75 links on Main cross street and six links on the west end, and ten  
 rods long in Clinton street. The whole now laid out, including streets and alleys contains seventeen acres, and seven  
 hundredths of an acre. The survey was made with a variation of 2 degrees 5 minutes west of the magnetic Meridian. The lot numbers  
 from 104 to 103 inclusive are four rods wide by ten rods long. Each lot is recorded in front of each lot.
