



SCHAPIER'S FIRST

Beginning at a stone on the South Bank of the Maumee River, and on the North and South one-half Section line of Section Eleven of Harrison Township, Henry County, Ohio; which stone is indicated as corner II in the record of the survey of said Section Eleven as recorded in the Henry County Surveyor's Record of Surveys, Vol. 1, Page 118; thence South on the aforesaid one-half Section line, 164 Feet; thence S 88° 40' E 1290 feet; thence North 109 feet to the low-water mark of the Maumee River; thence westerwardly along the said low water mark of the Maumee River, to the aforesaid one-half section line; thence south, on said one-half Section line 35" to the place of beginning; Containing 7.2 Acres of land.
