vicinity of Henry in the State of Ohio. Scale 10 rods to an inch.

Each of these sections is bounded and inclosed a they is enclosed wide. Each lot is four rods in front and ten rods back. Another lot is reserved along the street in front of each lot for side walks. The streets in traversing the prairie runs North thirty degrees west and are crossed obliquely angles by a street running North sixty degrees east. In the center of Main street about and on the north line of Street about one and a half miles N. E. 24.35 we have a station with a cross upon the same thing center of which cross is precisely in the center of the street of road and ten rods north and the center of Main Street itself is a second street with a like cross upon it. In the center of Street about a mile and directly in the east line of the cross about a third time and also ten rods east in the center of Street that is a fourth street both of which contains a cross of which is the precise center of Street that distance present.
