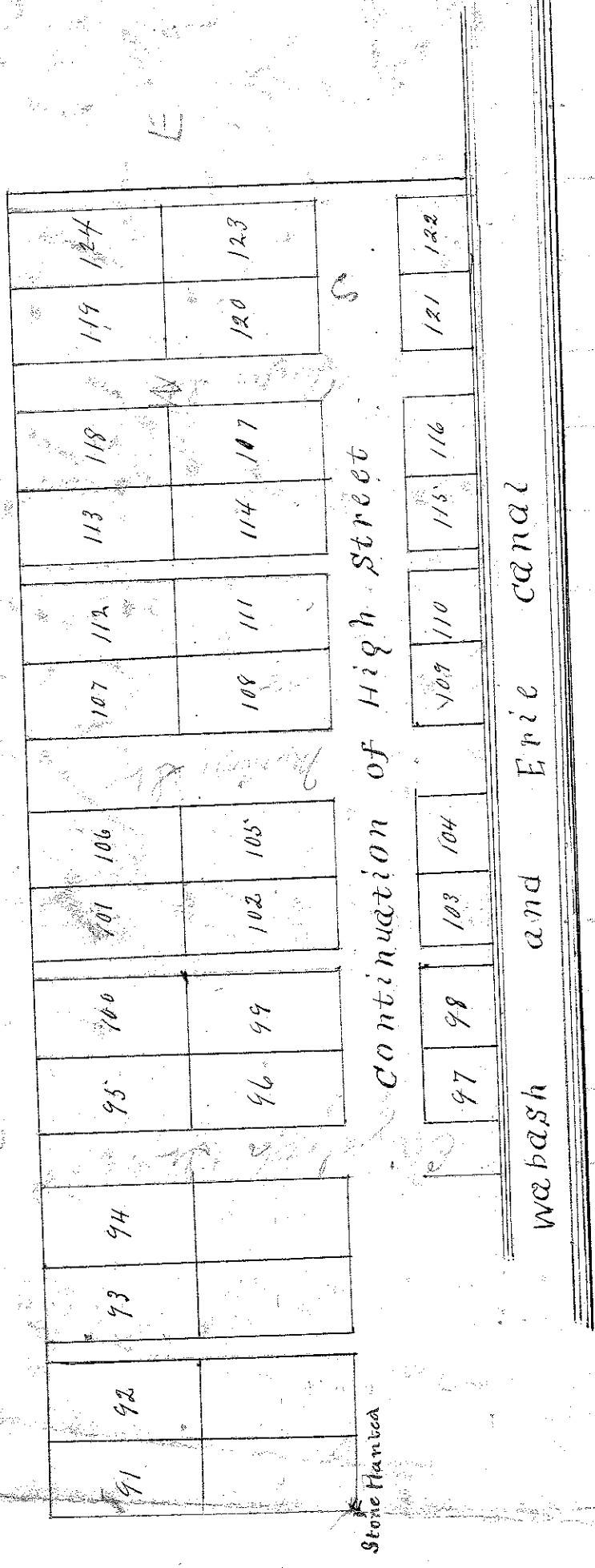


# Plat of Cooks second Addition to the Town of Florida



Explanation: The south west corner of No. 91 is north 42 degrees west 8 rods from a stone planted at the south west corner of Lot No. 2 in Cooks first addition to Florida. High street is 66 feet wide and bears north 48 degrees East Elizabeth and Chester are 37 feet wide Marion street is 60 feet wide, alleys Nos. 1 & 2 are 16 1/2 feet wide No. 3 is 19 feet wide No. 4 is 8 feet and 3 inches wide. The streets and alleys bear as do the lots north 48 degrees west, the ten lots bounded on the north by high street are 60 feet long to the Canal. The 24 lots north of high street are 132 feet long, all the lots are 66 feet wide.

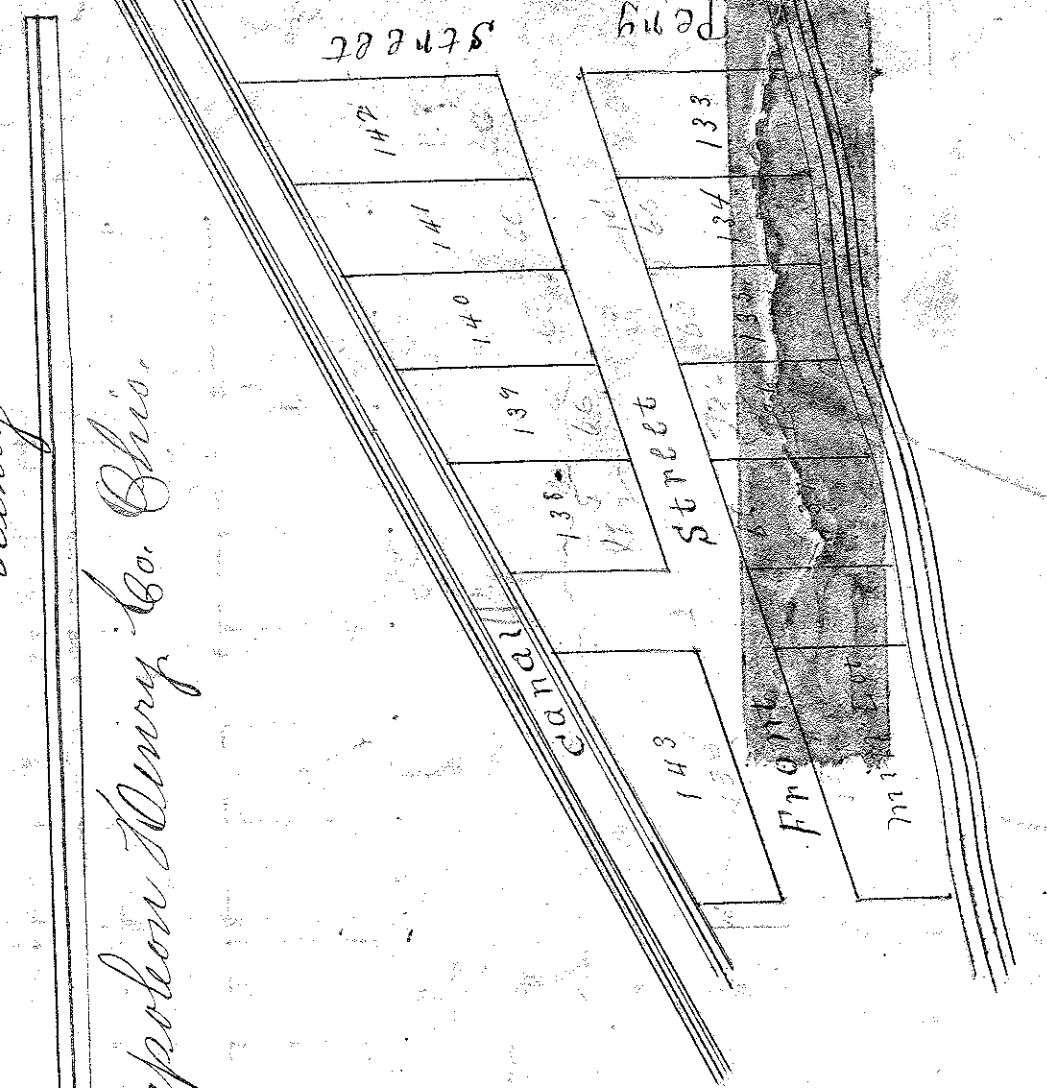

Beginning at the continuation of Front street at the point where it intersects Perry street running thence south 71 1/2 degrees west until it intersects a continuation of Scott street said Scott street being assumed 25 links taken from the east side thence continued, course from the west side of Scott street thence came to the west side of McElhott street Front street being assumed 25 links taken from the south side of Scott street thence came to the west side of McElhott street into five lots. The four lots on the east side being four rods wide each and the one on the west five rods wide. The Block on the south side of Front street is divided into five lots with an alley ten feet wide between the second and third numbering from the east all in this Block being four rods wide except the fourth numbering from the east which is increased 6 1/2 feet the line of said lots running parallel with Perry street and extending from Front street to the towing path on the canal on the north Block and from the street to the river on the south Block.
