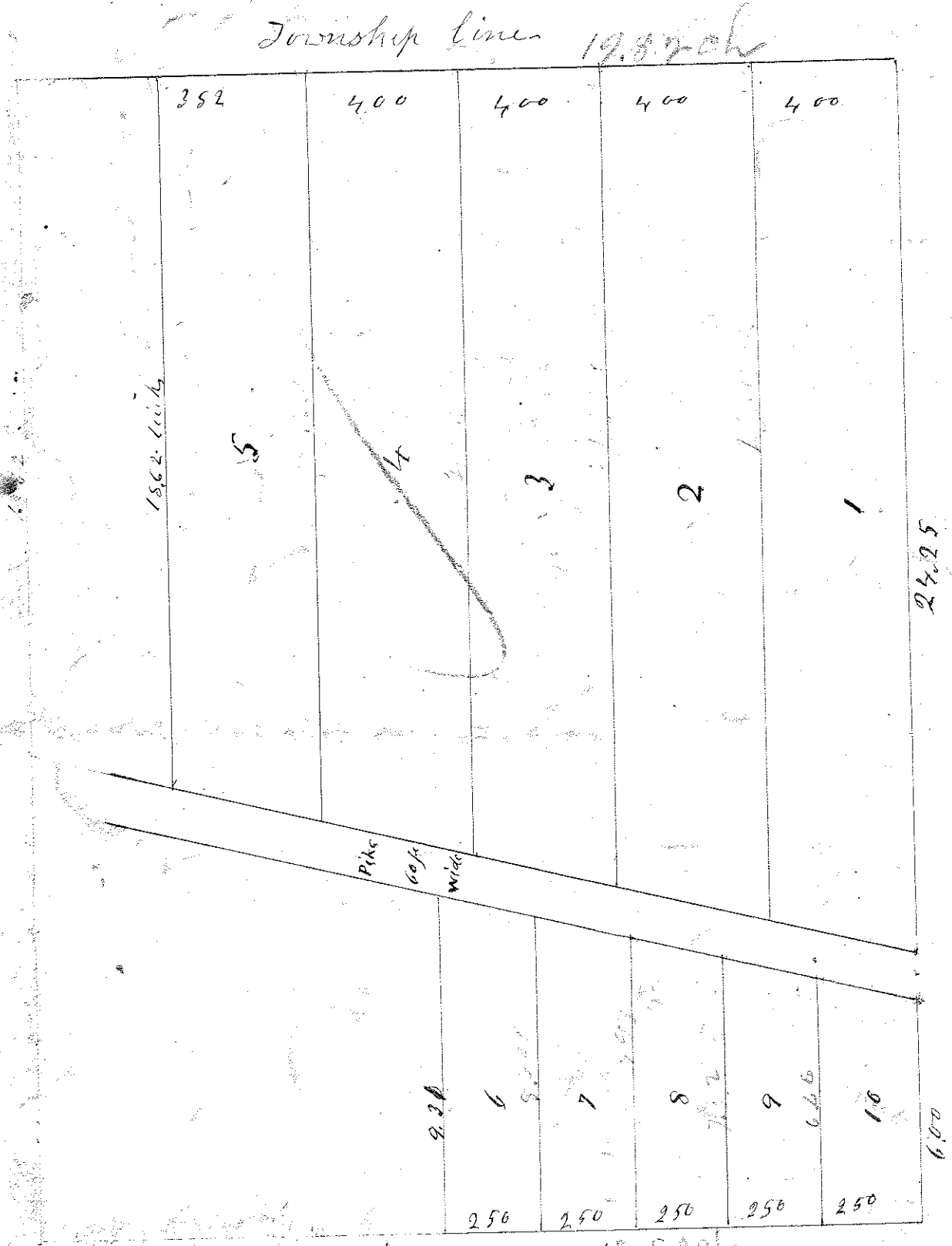
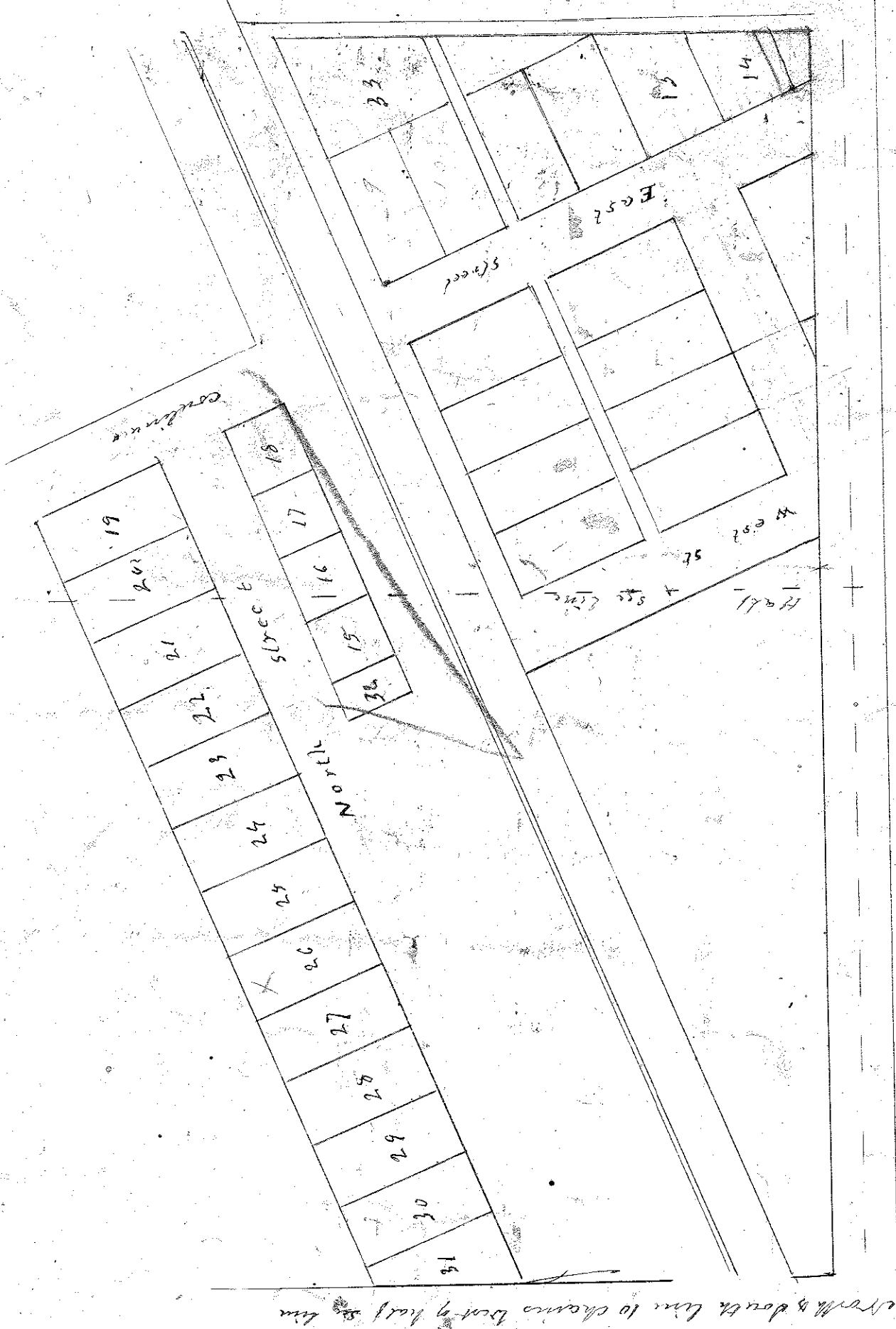


plat of north Napoleon

Field notes to the annexed plat -
 Commencing above the half section
 line of section number twelve (12) of
 Township Number Four North of
 Range Six East intersecting Range East
 six chains to the west line of the Adams
 plat; thence across said plat to a
 stake; thence same course twenty four
 chains and twenty five (24.25) links
 to the east quarter post of said section;
 thence north in the Township road
 three million chains and eighty two
 links (19.82) to a stake; thence
 eighteen chains, and sixty two links
 to the S.W. corner said. Thence
 along from a point on the west side
 of said plat the twelve chains and 50
 links north of the south line post above
 mentioned, west nine chains and thirty
 links to the place of beginning. The lots
 are 250 links wide, and those on the
 East side of the plat are 400 links wide
 excepting Lot number 5 which is only 382
 links wide. said lots and laid out on part
 of the North East fractional quarter of
 said section number 12, and contain an area of fifty two
 acres and sixty six one hundredths.

 the lines are the same as the original
 plat. The addition is the East alley, the
 continuation of East Street and North
 Street with lots numbered from 13 to 31
 inclusive and are laid off as approximate
 in the annexed plat. Lots 13 to 120
 links wide and extend to the alley. Lots 15
