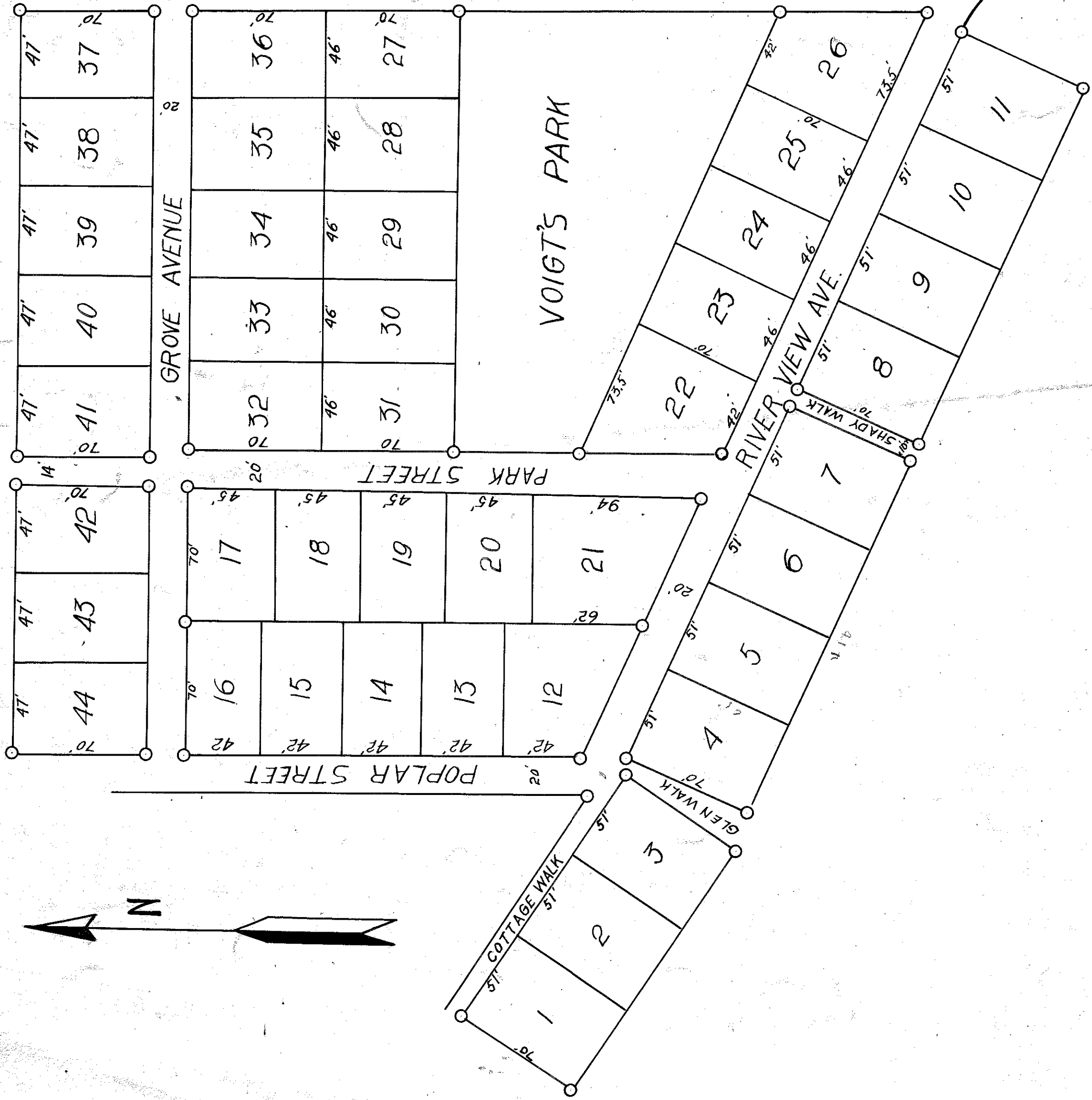
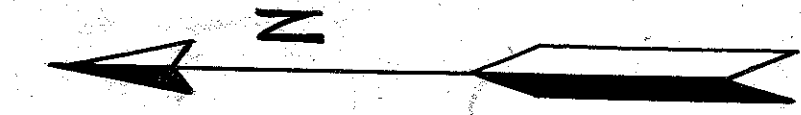

ADDITION

FIELD NOTES

Field notes to the Girty's Island Summer Home Company's first addition located on what is commonly called Girty's Island in the southwest corner of the southwest quarter of section two (2) and the southeast corner of the southeast quarter of section three (3), town four (4) north, range six (6) east, Flatrock township, Henry County Ohio.

The lots are divided into three (3) parcels.

Parcel #1. Beginning at a stone monument at the intersection of the East side of the street known as Poplar Street, and the North side of the avenue known as River View Ave. thence N 2-15' W for 300', thence North 87-45' E for 390', thence South 2-15' E. for 474', thence North 68-15' W for 427' to the point of beginning

Parcel #2. Beginning at a stone monument at the intersection of the East side of the street known as Poplar Street and the South side of the avenue known as River View Ave. thence South 21-40' West for 65', thence South 68-20' East for 418', thence North 21-40' East for 65', thence North 68-20' West for 418' to the point of beginning.

Parcel #3. Beginning at a stone monument at the intersection of the center line of a street known as Poplar Street and the South side of the street known as Cottage Walk thence North 60-25' West for 153' thence South 29-35' West for 70', thence South 60-25' East for 153' thence North 29-35' East, to the point of beginning.

Lots are of size and number as indicated on plat, and measured in feet.

Alleys, streets and park are of width and length indicated on plat.
