Field notes to William Sheffield first addition to the Town of Napelond. Valley Avenue is 100 links
The East line of which is parallel with and six links west of the section line between sections Hurlston and portion
Town Five North Range six East. Colinton Street is one hundred and twenty five links wide. The other streets
are each one hundred links wide and are at right angles to Valley Avenue. The alley along the Railroad
is fifty links wide. The others are each but only five links wide. The small figures on the plan and maps of the
show their dimensions in links. The whole lots alleys and streets here are one of seven fifty eight. There
are at the N.E. corner of Lot 9, Sheringa and Plaza June 19 AD 1866 for William Sheffield for a price of
No. 10 strong purveyors. I William Sheffield do hereby certify that the annexed Map and notes of the survey
thereof was made at my request and that I adopt the same as my first addition to the Town of Napelond and do hereby
to reserve the same as such. Wm Sheffield.

Napoleon. Field notes commencing in the east terminus of String Street in W. Sheffield's first addition to said Town
and continuing the same west with a Magnetic Meridian of $2^{\circ} 45'$ the same being at right angles with the East
line of Section 14 to the west line of the east half of the South East quarter of Section 14 T5 R. 6 E. the same being
and extension of Washington Street aforesaid, the width being four rods and the area two acres surveyed
April 12 1870 for the Proprietor Wm. Sheffield, and accepted by him as a second addition to the Town of
Napoleon Kings Co. H. Strong Surveyor
