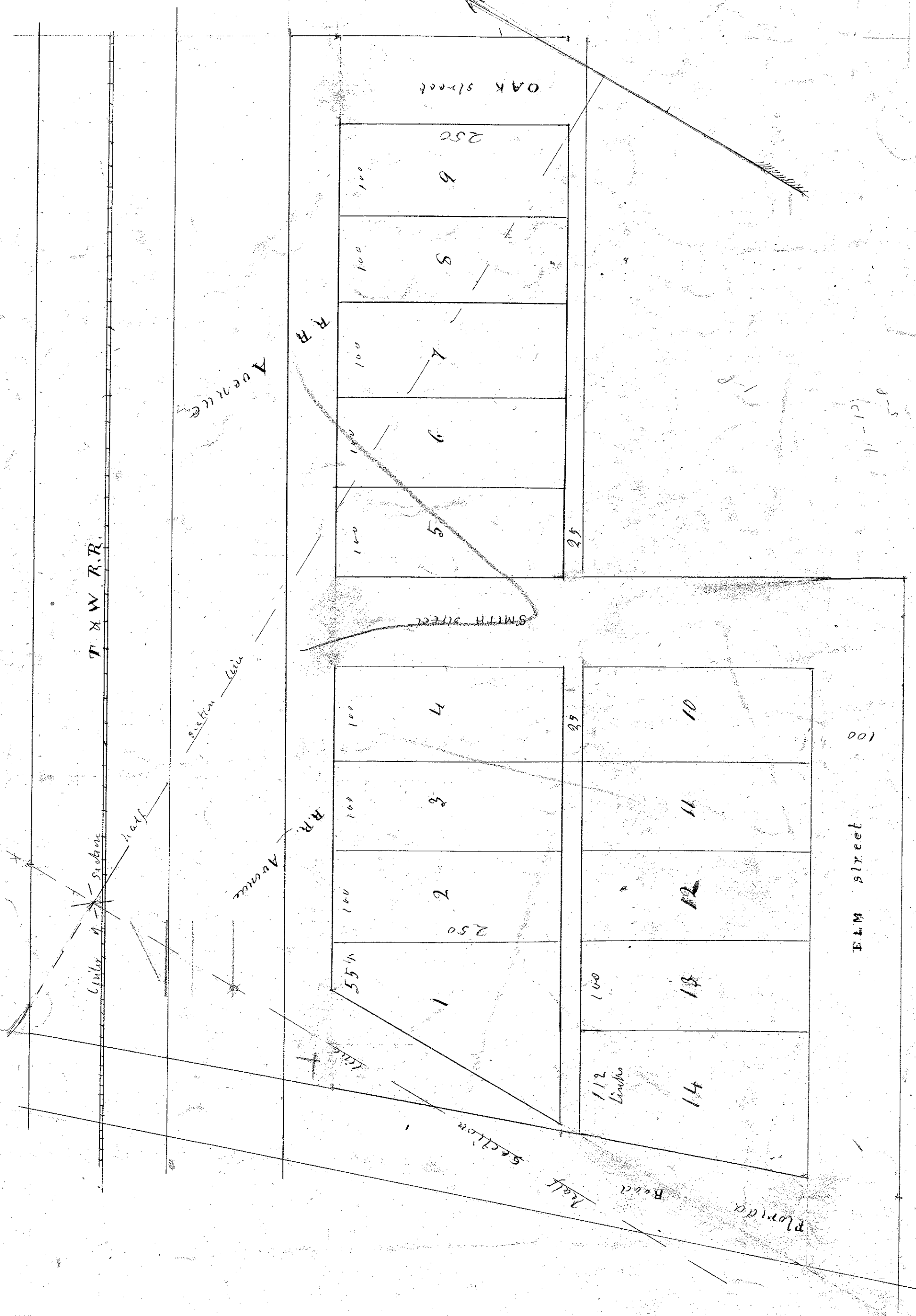


The State of Ohio Clinton County S.S. S.D.M. Collett being sworn says that on the second day of November 1869 I saw personally the within named Mary H. Smith with a true copy of the within notice D.M. Collett shown to and subscribed before me this 2^d day of November 1869 Mrs M.E. Curre S.S. And appeared on the 10 day of November 1869 the following order was returned to wit

County of Probate Henry County, Ohio to survey land into Town Lots

Virginia C. Smith Guardian of Mary H. Smith against her ward } This day Mrs Curre came on to be heard upon the petition and testimony and it appearing to the Court that legal notice of the pendency and prayer of this petition has been given to the defendant the evidence thereof with the return having been filed in this Court and the Court being fully advised in the premises do find that the statements in the petition are true and that it will be for the benefit of and advantage of said land to sell a portion of said land and further that it will be manifestly for the benefit of said ward to lay out that portion of the land aforesaid as is shown by the Plat attached to the petition into Town Lots it is therefore ordered by the Court that the said Virginia C. Smith guardian as aforesaid proceed to sign and acknowledge the Plat (a copy of which is attached to the petition) on behalf of said ward and cause the same to join with the petition and proceeding herein to be duly recorded according to the Statute in such case made, provided } signed S.M. Field Notes to the survey of the above annexed Plat of the Town of Okolona situated near the center of section 31 Town 5 North of Range 6 East and more particularly described as follows, from the southwest corner of the South West quarter of said section 31 south on half section line two chains and eighty four links to a stone thence same course thirty seven links thence North 60° East 50 links to the North West corner of lot 10 1/2 thence same course past the ends of lots 1, 2, 3, 4 to South Street thence same course 100 links across said street to the Northwest corner of Lot 5, thence same course past the ends of lots 5, 6, 7, 8, 9 to the West line of Oak Street the last named line is parallel with the back of the East Road and two chains and 15 links thence. The whole Plat is laid out as represented. The figures on the ends and sides of the lots show their dimensions in links or also the width of the strips and an alley. The whole Plat contains 5 1/2 acres. I certify the above to be correct Nov 10 1869 H.M. Hagg Surveyor.
