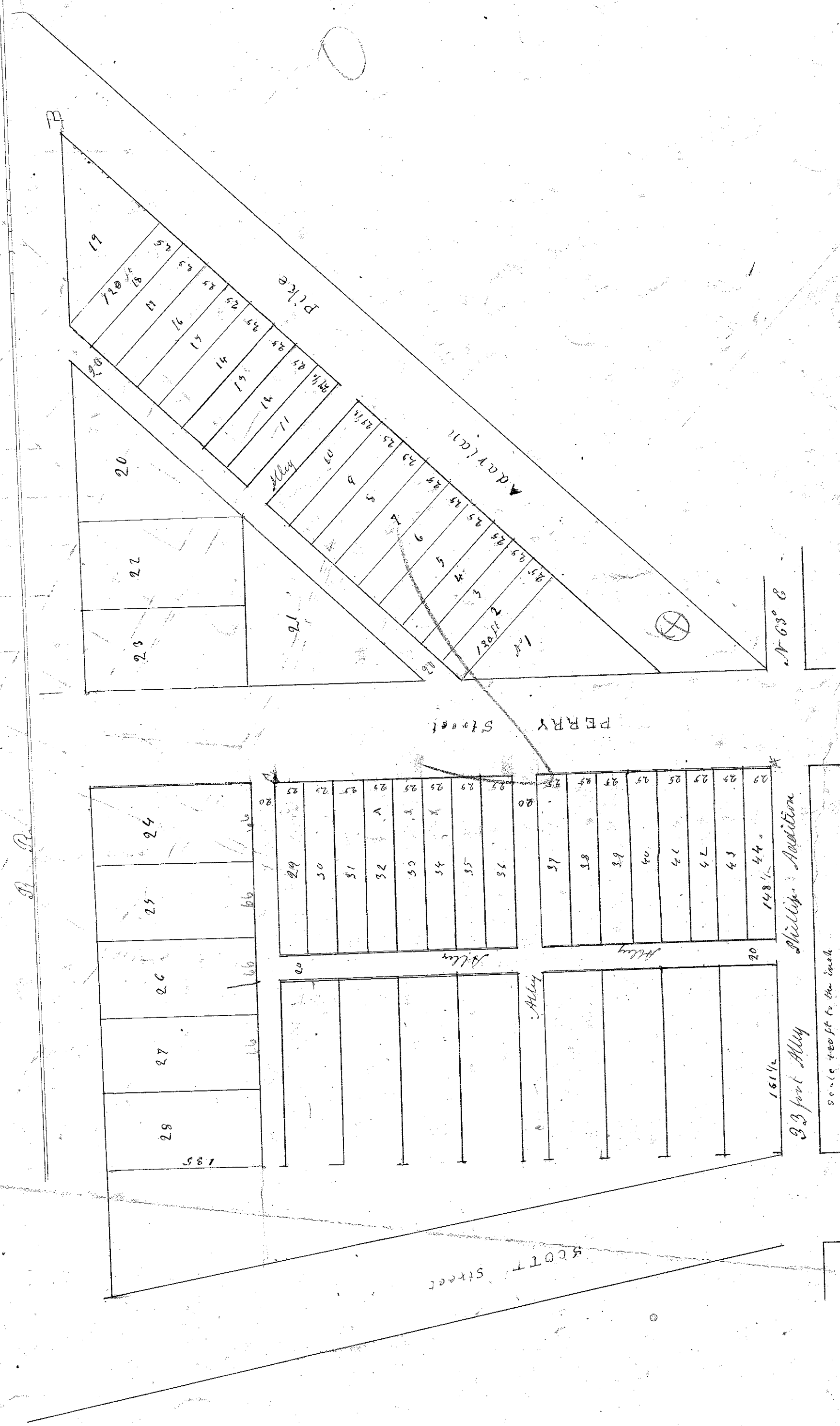


Plat of Henry Yeagers Third Addition to the Town of Napoleon



Field notes of the survey of Henry Yeagers Third Addition to the Town of Napoleon. This Plat covers a part of section 13-15-21-22 East and is bounded on the North by the Town Road, on the East by the American Pike and south by a 33 foot alley of Henry Yeagers addition to the Town of Napoleon surveyed by H. Yeagers and Co. Reiler Sept 9-1870 for the proprietor Henry Yeagers. The enclosed plat is a true representation of the survey. The several figures showing the length and width of each lot, except Lot 2 is clipped on the NW corner 34 1/2 in with the West line and 2 feet 8 inches on the South line. Lot 22 is also clipped on the South East corner 9 ft 7 inches on the East line and 8 feet 7 inches on the South. Streets are planned at the corners A, B, C, D.
