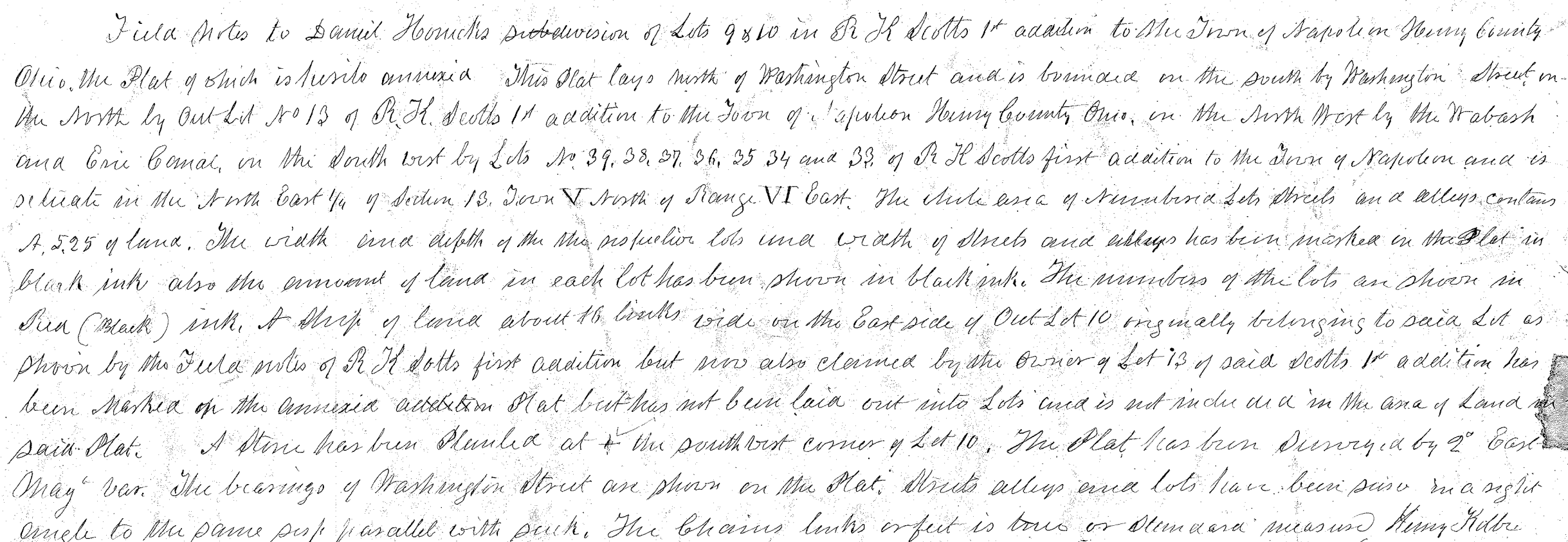

degrees west one chain distant from the North East corner of Lot number fifty
four in the Original Plat. The South line bears North eighty one degrees West
and parallel with the North line of the Original Plat one chain and
seventy five links to the South East Corner. The East line bears North two chains
one and one half links to the North East Corner. The North line bears South
Eighty one degrees West, and parallel with the line two chains and six links
to the North West corner. The West line bears South nine degrees East at
right angles with the Original Plat two Chains to the South West corner
and place of beginning. Church and Forest Streets are one Chain or sixty
six feet wide. Thirty three feet of which was platted with the Survey the
balance surveys. The Alley on north of Lot is sixteen feet wide -
