



Town Plat of Napoleon Henry County Ohio. A Plat and field notes of the first addition to the Town Plat of the Town of Napoleon
 in Henry County and State of Ohio as follows in connection with the original Plat to wit: beginning at the North West corner of Lot No 97
 of the Original Town Plat thence South 64° W. 1.25 chains to the N.E. corner of Lot 10 in Block No 1. of the first addition to the
 Town Plat of said Town of Napoleon: thence S 64° W. 500 chains to the N.W. corner of said Block No 1 and to the East side of Scott
 Street: thence South 26° East 2.50 chains to the North side of an alley thence same course ^{25 links} across said Alley: thence the same
 course 250 links to the S.W. corner of said Block No 1 and to the North side of Washington Street continued: thence same
 course 1.25 chains across said Street continued and to the N.W. corner of Block No 2 of said first addition, at which a stone is planted
 and marked at the top with a cross. thence the same course 200 chains to the S.W. corner of Block No 2 of said first addition
 N side of an alley: thence 25 links the same course across the said alley: thence same course 250 chains to the S.W. corner of Block No 2
 of said first addition and to the North line of Main Street continued: thence same course 1.25 chains across said Street and to
 the N.W. corner of Lot 22 of said first addition: thence the same course 162 chains to the S.W. corner of Lot No 22 of said first addition
 thence the same course 140 chains across said Taylor Street and to the S.W. corner of Lot No 21 of the Basin fraction: thence the
 same course 162 chains to the N.W. corner of Lot No 23 and North side of Basin alley: thence N. 37° E. 5.59 chains to the N.W.
 North side of said alley, to the S.E. corner of Lot 11 of the Basin fraction and to the W side of Perry Street: S 26° W 102 chains
 a stone planted and marked with a cross on the top at the S side of Basin Alley: thence from said fractional corner N. 26° W 102 chains
 to the S.E. corner of said fraction Lot No 11 and to the South side of Taylor Street: thence same course 140 chains across said Street and
 to the S.E. corner of Lot 10 of Block 2 of said first addition: thence same course 178 chains to the alley: thence the same course 178 links to a stone planted in
 the middle of the alley at the West side of the Street: thence the same course 124 links to the N side of the alley: thence same course 250 chains to the
 S.E. corner of said Block No 2 and to the South side of Washington Street continued: thence same course 1.25 chains to the corner said Street and to the South
 E corner of Block No 1. of said first addition: thence the same course 250 chains to an Alley: thence the same course 25 links across said
 alley: thence the same course 2.50 chains to the S.E. corner of said Block No 1. and to the South side of Clinton Street. The lots in Block No 1 of said
 added on the Plat below are four rods wide and ten rods long, and the lots in No 2 are four rods wide and eight rods long: each Lot No 10
 which is clipped at the S.E. corner by the Street as follows: commencing at the corner of it running South 31° W 50 links to the North side of
 Main Street continued: thence S. 64° W to the South West corner of said Lot 10 (the lots in the fraction along the Basin Alley are 45 links
 wide and 91 links long each No 11 which is 40 links at the South and 96 links wide at the N end, and Lot No 21 which is 107 links
 at the S end and 534 links wide at the N end. The Streets are four rods wide and the alleys are one rod wide. There is on each side of each
 street an paved for side walks. I do hereby certify this to be a true and correct field notes of the survey by me made June 22 1848
 for H. G. Phillips and others and that at that time I was County Surveyor of Henry County. Napoleon Henry County Ohio 6th June 1848
