


Plan & Map of Cook's addition to the

Explanation of the Map and plan of Cooks Addition to the Town of Florida 1st High Street continued
lays parallel with the canal. 2^d The South West corner of lot No 2 is at right angles with the south lines
of lots Nos 6 7 & 8. Cooks and Goodyears addition end is 66 feet from the south East corner of lot 6 making
James Street 66 feet wide at that point. 3^d There is a stone planted at the south west corner of lot
No 2 for governing the paving and future surveys as prescribed in the Statute's 4th High Street
extended bears North 48° East and its width is 66 feet. and the north and south line on the East side
of James Street and of each lot bears North 42° West 5 Lots No 1. 3 5 & 7 are 66 feet front and bound
on the Canal on the south. 6th Lots 2 4 6 & 8 are 66 feet front and 132 deep. 7th The alleys are 16 $\frac{1}{2}$
wide and lie North and South. I hereby certify the foregoing Plan and Map to be a true representation.

Plan of Jenks, Henry County Ohio. This Village is situated upon the North Margin of the Wabash and Erie Canal and at the mouth of and upon the West bank of Bad creek being part of the West fraction of the North East fractional quarter of Section four in Township five North of Range Eight East and a part of the North West fractional quarter of the same section. It is laid out as shown by the foregoing plan and the subjoined Explanations. The streets are laid out to the cardinal points with an allowance of two degrees for variation except Canal or first Street, a part of which conforms to the meanders of the Wabash and Erie Canal on its Northern margin, and also Mill Street conforming to the same on the South Margin of said Canal. The courses of said meanders being indicated upon the Plan. The Streets are all sixty feet wide except Broad Street which is sixty six feet wide and Main Street is fifty feet wide. The alleys are twelve feet wide and run East and West. There are one hundred and forty two lots in the foregoing Plan the sizes of which are set out in the following list to wit: Lots numbering 14, 15, 16, 17, 18, 19, 20, 21, 30, 31, 32, 33, 34, 35, 36, 37, 38, 39, 40, 41, 42, 43, 44, 45, 46, 47, 51, 82 & 138, are each sixty six feet front by one hundred and thirty two feet deep. Lots numbers 58, 49, 66, 61, 62, 63, 64, 65, 72, 73, 74, 75, 104, 105, 106, 107, 108, 109, 110, 111, 112, 113, 114, 106, 116, 117, 118, 119, 120, 121, 126, 127, are each sixty six 66 feet front by 159 feet deep. Lots numbers 66, 67, 68, 69, 70, 71, 86, 87, 88, 89, 90, 91, 92, 93, 94, 95, 96, 97, 98, 99, 122, 123, 124, 125, are each 79 $\frac{1}{2}$ feet front by 132 feet deep. Lots numbers 52, 53, 54, 55, 56, 57, 74, 75, 76, 77, are each 66 feet front by 105 feet deep. The above comprising all the regular lots. The fractional lots and blocks are as follows viz: 1st The Block containing lots numbers 1, 2, 3, 4, is six feet on the West line, 264 feet on the North line, or 66 feet front to each lot and 35 feet on East line and bounding the canal on the South line. 2nd The Block containing numbers 5, 6, 7, 8, is 35 feet on the West line, 264 feet on the North line (66 feet front to each lot) and six feet on the East line and bounded by the Canal on the South line. 3rd The Block containing lots No. 9, 10, 11, 12, 13, 132, 183, is 132 feet on the West line, 462 feet on the North line (or 66 feet wide for each lot). 4th The Block containing lots Nos. 134, 135, 136, 137, is 264 feet on the south and 66 feet wide for each lot. 66 feet on the West line and 45 feet on the East line and bounded on the North by Bad Creek. 5th The Block containing 23, 24, 25, 26, is 73 feet on the West line, 264 feet on the North line (being 66 feet wide for each lot) 120 feet on the East line and bounded on the South by first street. 6th The Block containing lots Nos. 26, 27, 28, 29, is 154 feet on the West line, 264 feet on the North line being 66 feet wide for each lot, and 66 feet on the East line and bounded on the South by first Street. 7th The Block containing Nos. 48, 49, 50 & 51, is 264 feet on Muscoda Street being 66 in width for each lot by 100 feet deep bounded by Bad creek on the North and cardinal meridians lines for the dividing lines. 8th The Block No. 78, is 54 feet on Third Street and 110 on Cherry Street running by a straight line. 9th The Block containing Nos. 97 & 80, is 150 feet on the West line, 132 feet on Third Street & 117, forty seven feet on the East line. 10th Lot No. 83 is 132 feet on the South line 66 on the West & 6, feet on the North 50 feet in the East line by a straight line. 11th The Block No. 100, 101, 102, 103, is 100 feet on West line, 264 feet on the North line (being 66 feet wide for each lot) 138 $\frac{1}{2}$ feet on the East line and bounded on the South by first street. 12th The Block containing lots Nos. 128, 129, 130, 131, is 89 feet on the West line, 264 on the North line (is 66 feet wide for each lot), 94 feet wide on the east and bounded south by first street. The cardinal meridians divide all these fractional lots at the distance of 66 feet apart as in plan. 13th The Block on Mill Street and South side of the canal and immediately adjoining

The No 12. of said canal is 120 feet on Mill Street being 30 feet front for each lot, 38 feet on the West line and 40 feet
on line, the lots being separated by Cardinal masonry. Stones are placed at the South West corners of Lots No 20.
No 149. for the setting out of various points for future surveys, agreeably to the requirements of the Statute, relative to
