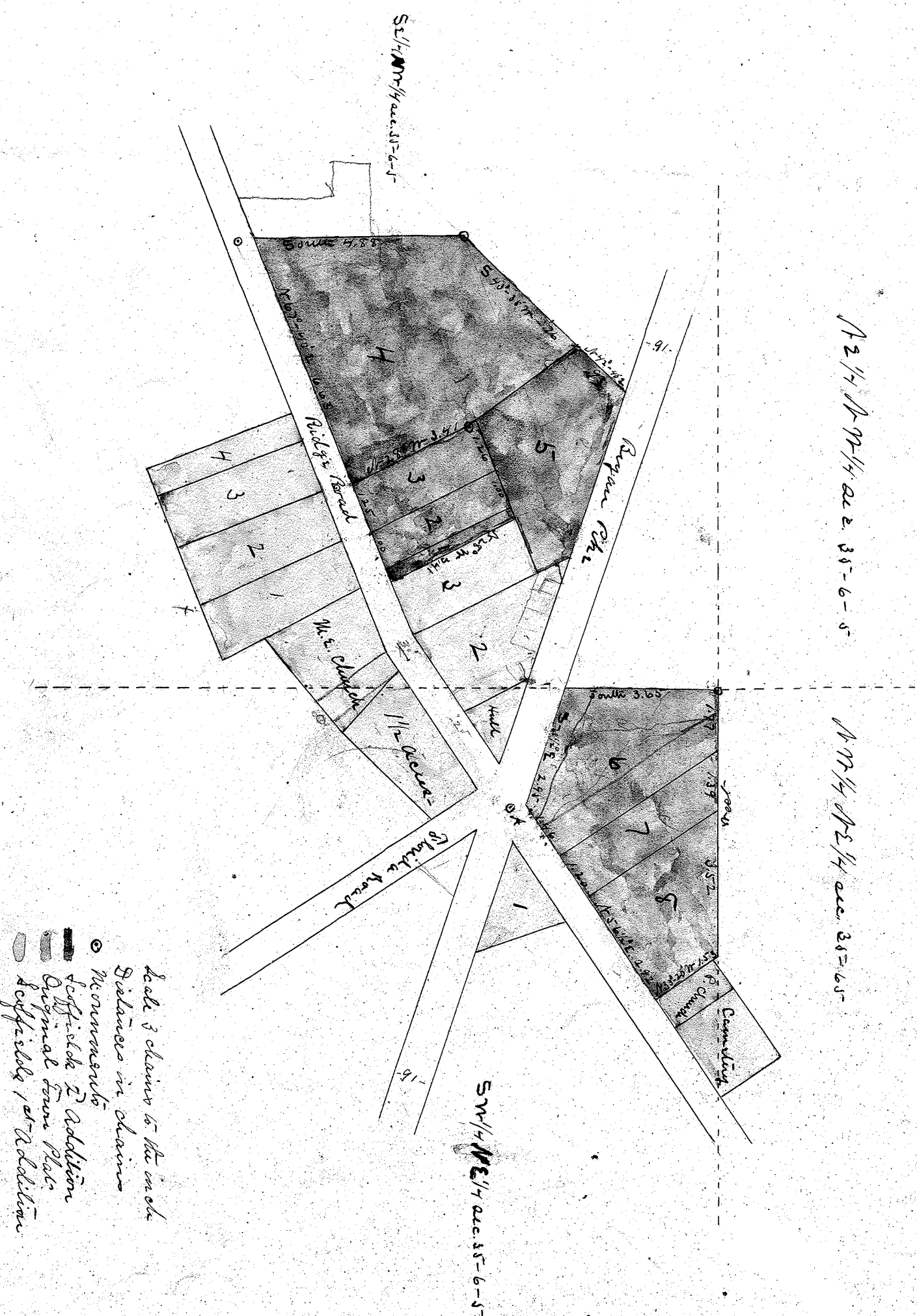

Field notes of survey of Hofffields 2 addition to the town of Ridgeville. Henry County, Ohio - This addition is in two adjacent tracts - Tract No. 1, 352 acres, as follows: Tract 1 being a part of the south-west 1/4 of the north-east 1/4 of section 25, Town 6 North, Range 2, 132 East, Henry County, Ohio, bounded as follows, commencing at the south-west corner of the south-west 1/4 of the north-east 1/4 of said section 25, thence south along the north-line of said north-east 1/4 section 25, 3.65 chains to the north line of the Morgan Pike, thence south 1/2 East along the north line of said Morgan Pike 2.98 chains to the West line of Ridge road, thence north 54 1/2 East along the West line of said Ridge road 1.98 chains, thence north 80 1/2 West, 1.32 chains to the north line of said south-east 1/4 of the north-east 1/4 section 25, then a west along the north line of said north-east 1/4 of the north-east 1/4 section 25 to 68 chains to the place beginning containing same. Tract No. 2, described as follows: Tract 1 being a part of the east 1/2 of the north-east 1/4 section 25, Town 6 North, Range 2, 132 East, Henry County, Ohio, bounded as follows, commencing at the intersection of the north line of the Ridge road with the west line of the Ridge road thence in a southeasterly direction along the north line of Ridge road to a point on the west line of said Ridge road, 1.06 chains distant from above measured point, in the original town plat of Ridgeville, thence north 47 1/2 East, 3.76 chains thence north 47 1/2 East, .93 chains, thence in a southeasterly direction along the north line of the Morgan Pike to place of beginning (the spring water of arm described tract contained in the original township of the town of Ridgeville containing same, Tract No. 25 contained same, and are subdivided as shown by plat. The land herein will respectively be fields 2 & 3 addition.
