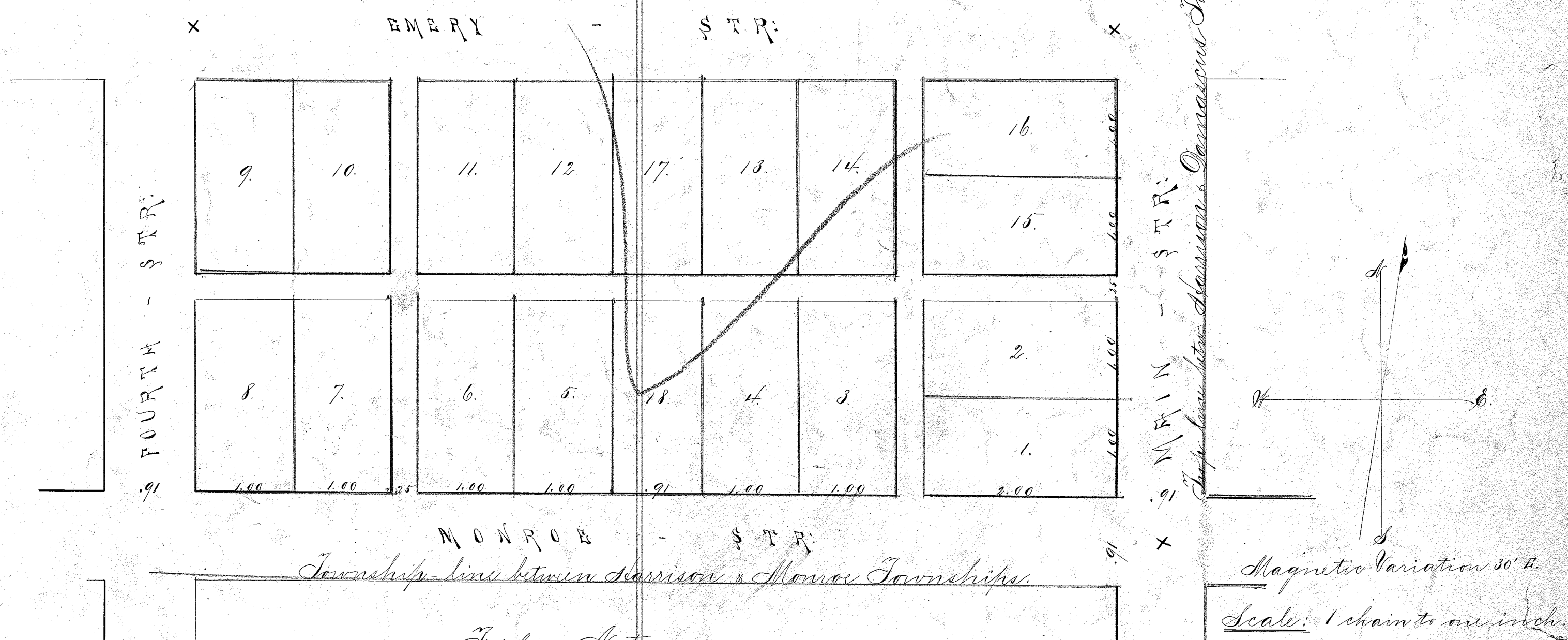


PLAT

HENRY - COUNTY, O.



Field Notes

The Plat is situated in the Southeast corner of the S. E. 1/4 of the S. E. 1/4 of Section thirty six (36) in Town five (5) North Range seven (7) East, Henry County, Ohio, and is described and bounded as follows:

Commencing at a stone at the corner of the four Townships of Damascus, Harrison, Richfield and Monroe and running thence West along the line between Monroe and Harrison Townships to the West line of Fourth Street, a distance of 10.775 chains; thence North 5.612 chains to North line of Emery Street, thence East 10.775 chains to the line between Harrison and Damascus Townships (the center of Main Street); thence South 5.615 chains to the place of beginning. - The whole area of this land embraced in said plat is: 6.05 acres. - Each street is 60 feet or 91 links wide, each alley is one rod or 25 links wide, each lot is four rods wide by eight rods deep except lots 17, 18 which are 60 feet wide by 8 rods deep; which said dimensions have been shown on the plat in black ink. The numbers of lots on said plat have been marked in red ink. - The following stones have been followed, planted, to wit: 1st in the center of Emery Street and on the East line of Fourth Street. 2^d at the West line of Main Street and the center of Emery Street. There is also a stone at the Southeast corner of the above described plat, and 80 rods West at the S. E. corner of S. E. 1/4 S. E. 1/4 section 36 Harrison Townships will be found a fourth stone; said stone marked x. - Surveyed and platted for the proprietor William Mead at his request and in accordance with his directions, this 28th day of July 1850 A. D.
