Field Notes

to the village of Malinta, Monroe Township, Henry County, Ohio.

The Plat is situated at in the West part of the $T. 4 N. 14$ section eleven (11) as follows: Commencing at the point where the section line between sections eleven (11) and ten (10) of said $T. 4 N. 14$ R. 7 E. crosses the North line of the Toledo Delphos and Burlington Rail Road and being chains South of the $T. 4 N. 14$ corner of the Sec. 10 & 11 to North line of Main Street, a distance of 12 chains; thence East 7.91 chains to a stone, thence $N. 56^{\circ} 30' E.$ 7.20 chains, thence $S. 55^{\circ} 30' E.$ 5.52 chains to the North line of the $T. 4 N. 14$ R. 7 E. along said R. R. to the place of beginning, containing an area of 11.36 acres of land; and also for lot #22 (marked Depot Ground on said Plat) commencing at the point where East line of Henry Street extended will cross the South line of said $T. 4 N. 14$ R. 7 E. and running thence $N. 56^{\circ} 30' E.$ along said R. R. a distance of 7.00 chains, thence $S. 55^{\circ} 30' E.$ (at right angle to said R. R.) a distance of 7.50 chains; thence North to the place of beginning. - Said lot #22 contains: 0.54 acres, the balance of said plat 11.36 acres, a total area of land - 11.90 acres. The width and depth of the rep. lots has been shown on the plat in chains in black ink; also the width of the streets and alleys. The numbers of the lots have been shown in red ink. Surveyed and platted for the proprietor, John Bensing and in accordance with his instructions and deeded on the 15th day of July A. D. 1880.
