

Field Notes

to
John Mc Clure's First Addition
to the Village of Mc Clure,
Henry County, Ohio.

This plat is situated in the southeast corner $SE\frac{1}{4}$ $SE\frac{1}{4}$ Section twenty eight (28) of Damascus Township (T. 5 N. R. 8 E. Henry County, Ohio, it lays immediately south of the town of Mc Clure and is bounded as follows:

Commencing at the south line of Summit Street of said town of Mc Clure in the center of a road on line between Sec. 27 & 28 and running thence south along said section line to the SE corner of $SE\frac{1}{4}$ $SE\frac{1}{4}$ Sec. 28 a distance of 9.32 chains (which point is marked by a stone *) thence west along the south line of said tract of land to a stone (marked x on the Plat) to the west line of Beaver Creek continuing a distance of 10.75 chains, thence north along West side of Beaver Creek continued 9.32 chains to South side of Summit Street, thence east along said street 10.75 ch. to the place of beginning.

The plat embraces an area of 10.02 acres of land.

Lots, streets and alleys are laid out as shown on the plat, which shows the dimensions in feet. The number of said lots are shown on the plat in red ink.
