

Small Plat of Napoleon Second Addition.



A plat and field notes to the second addition to the Town of Napoleon laid out by J. B. Phillips and Samuel to Stafford Nov. 1851. A. D. 1851. in connection with the Original Plat of said town to wit: beginning at the south west corner of lot number 113 as now laid off being north 28° west on chain and twenty five links from the north west corner of lot 113 of the first addition then north 65° east along the north line of Clinton street crossing Perry Street Main Street and Jefferson street at right angles. The streets last named are contained the same spaces as laid out in the Original Plat 275 chains to an alley two rods wide and the entire north side of said new addition and on the west side of lot No. 113 as aforesaid in the plat hereto attached.

I hereby certify the foregoing to be a correct and true and field notes of said second addition made to the Town of Napoleon as sworn by me the 14th day of November A. D. 1851.
