

Field Notes
to
H. C. Clay's First Addition
to
the Village of Grellton, Henry Co., Ohio.

The plat is situated in the northeast corner of Sec. 1, Monroe Township (Town 4 North, Range 7 East), Henry County, Ohio, less 4 acres off of said corner marked, Saw Mill Lot on the annexed plat, and is bounded and described as follows:

Commencing ten rods south of the northeast corner of section 1 of the aforesaid township of Monroe and running thence west along the line of said Saw Mill Lot a distance of $46\frac{1}{2}$ feet; thence south ten feet across an alley to the N. W. corner of Lot 11; thence south 132 feet along the westline of Lot 11; thence south 50 feet across a street, thence south $27\frac{1}{4}$ feet along west line of Lot 12 to the north boundary of the Toledo, Delphos and Burlington Railroad; thence north $55\frac{1}{2}^{\circ}$ East along said railroad a distance of about 585 feet to the point where the north line of said railroad crosses the line between Monroe and Richfield Townships; thence north along said township line 142 feet to the place of beginning. This tract contains 3.32 acres of land. - And also beginning at the point where the south line of said T. D. & B. R. R. crosses the township line between Monroe and Richfield Townships and running thence south to a stone 284 feet (4.30 ch.) which stone is 40 rods south of a stone at the S. E. corner of Monroe Township. - thence 440 feet west to the south line of said R. R. a distance of about 505 feet to the place of beginning. This second tract contains 1.34 acres of land. The total area included in this plat is 4.66 acres of land. The subdivision of said two tracts has been shown on the annexed plat; distances are given in feet. The numbers of lots have been shown in red ink.

Surveyed and platted at the request of the proprietor, H. C. Clay, and in accordance with his instructions, this 23rd day of December 1880 A.D. Henry Kolbe, Surveyor.

To all persons to whom these presents shall come, greeting: Know ye, That I, H. C. Clay, do hereby certify, that I am the owner in fee of the real estate described in the field notes of the accompanying plat of H. C.
