

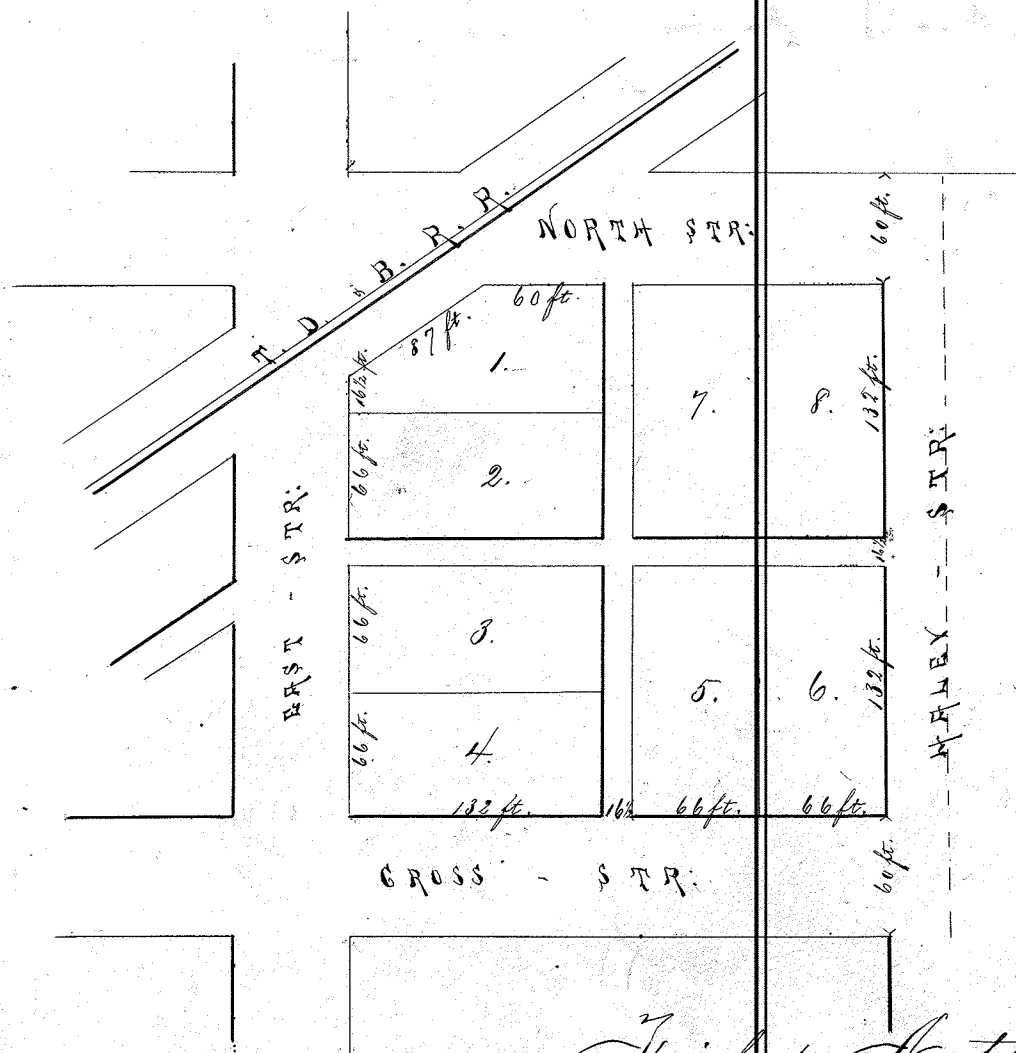
PLAT

Field Notes.

Being the North West corner of the West half of the North West quarter of section No. 27, Town 5 N. R. 8 E., (Cann. sec. 21, 22, 27 & 28 Town 5 Range 4 of said, running thence east along said section line between sec. 22 & 27 three hundred forty and one half (340 1/2) feet; thence south three hundred twenty and one half (320 1/2) feet; thence west three hundred forty and one half (340 1/2) feet to the line between sec. 27 & 28; thence north along section line 370 1/2 ft. to the place of beginning; and containing two and eighty nine hundredths acres (2.89). Amount to be deducted from said tract for T. D. & B. R. R. is 1/100 of an acre leaving 2 7/10 acres included in lots, streets and alleys in above addition to the Village of Mc Clure: I certify the above to be a correct plat and field notes of the above mentioned addition to the Village of Mc Clure as surveyed by me February 26th 1881.
