

John Pensing's ^{to} First Addition to the Village of
Malinta, Henry County, Ohio.

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The plat is situated immediately south of the Village of "Madrasta" in the south west corner, West part NW¹/₄ of Section eleven (11), Town four (4) North, Range seven (7) East, Hurry County, Ohio, and is bounded and described as follows: commencing at a stone x at the SW corner NW¹/₄ of said sec. 11, T. 4 N. R. 7 E. and running thence north along the line between sec. 10 & 11 a distance of 8.93 chains to the south line of the Toledo, Delphos and Burlington Rail Road, thence N 56° 30' E. along the south line of said Railroad to the east line of Hurry Street a distance of about 6.80 chains, thence south about 90 links to along Depot Grounds, thence North 56° 30' E. along S. side of Depot Grounds to the East line of an alley - a distance of about 2.67 ch., thence south along said alley 13.30 ch. to the center of a Township road on the half section line, thence west along said half section line 7.91 chains to the place of beginning.

The area of land contained in said plat (incl. lots, streets, alleys, country and township roads) is 8.95 acres. The subdivision of the tract of land described in these notes has been shown on the plat; dimensions of lots and streets are given in chains on exterior lines. Numbers of lots are shown in red figures.
