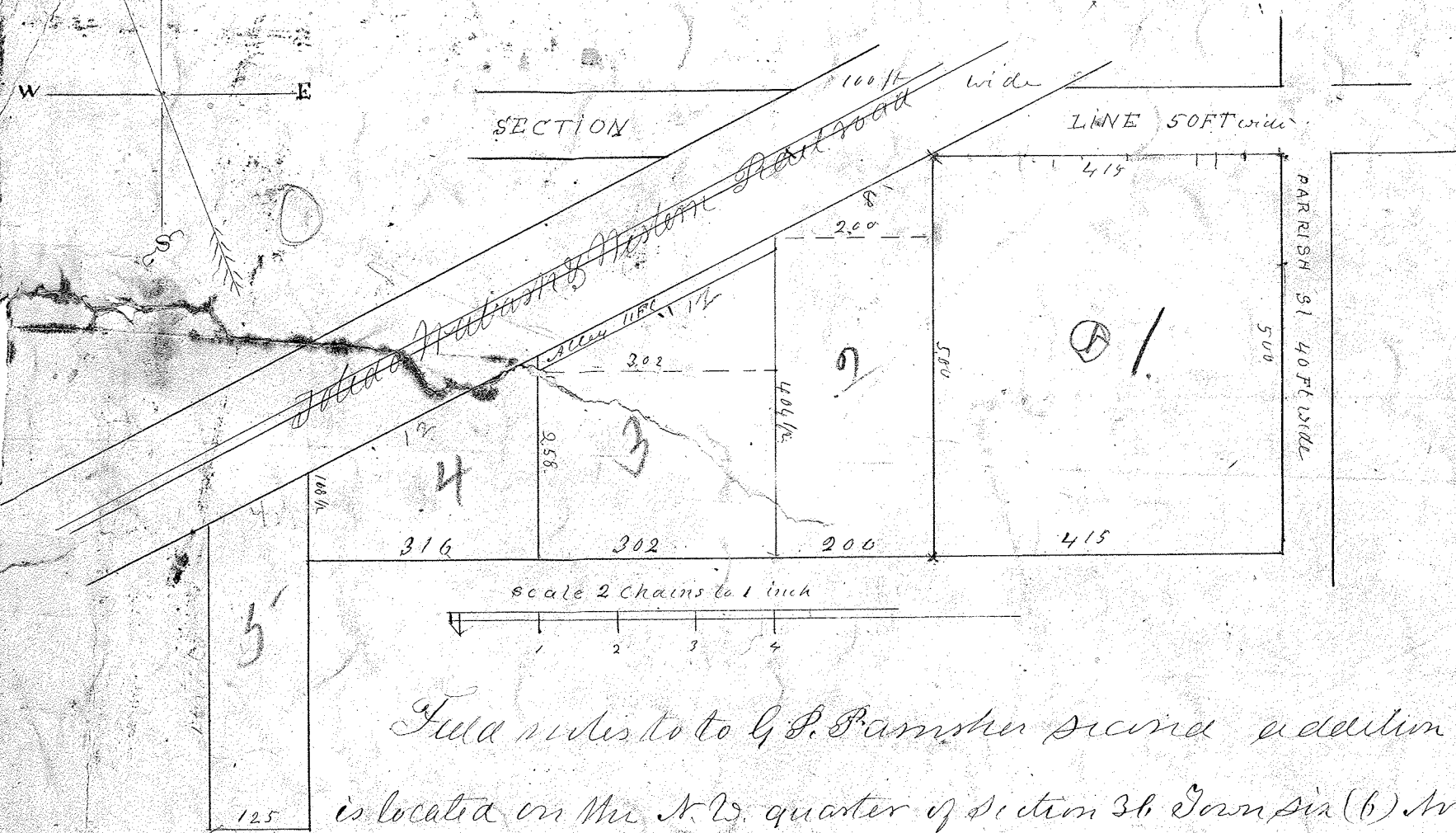
Field notes to the village of Kaufmansville Henry County Ohio the Plat being situated in the East part of the N. E. 1/4 section 2 Pleasant Township Henry County Ohio surveyed and located at the request and instruction of Mr. Kaufman Proprietor on the 25 day of ^{September} AD 1873 as follows commencing at the stone planted at the corner of section 2 and Town 3 North Range 6 East at the south line of said Township thence following the line between sections 1 and 2 in said Pleasant Township 67 rods and 8 links thence west 18 rods and 20 links thence north and parallel with the section line 67 rods and 8 links thence East along the Township line between Pleasant and Flat Rock Townships a distance of 18 rods and 20 links to the place of beginning the width and depth of the lots is shown in the Plat in chains and links in black ink also the width of streets and alleys. The numbers of the lots is shown in red ink [black ink] The whole area of numbered lots including streets and alleys is 74 acres of land Henry Colby County Surveyor.

I William Kaufman do hereby certify that the annexed Plat and the Field Notes of the survey thereof were made at my request and in accordance with my instructions and that I adopt the same as the Village of Kaufmansville and wish to record the same as such Wm Kaufman.

Plat of G. P. Parish's second addition to the Town of Liberty Center



Field notes to G. P. Parish's second addition to the Town of Liberty Center Ohio. The Plat is located on the N. E. quarter of section 36 Town 34 North Range 6 East and is immediately west of G. P. Parish's First addition to said Town and is more particularly described as follows. Commencing at the North East corner of Lot No 1 which corner is 25 feet south of section line and 20 feet east of the center of Parish Street thence west to the intersection of the Toledo, Wabash and Western Railway about 17 rods and 15 links thence south 67° West parallel with the T. W. Railway about 37 rods 10 links thence south 16 rods thence East 5 rods thence North 13 rods and 10 links thence East 49 rods 18 1/2 links thence North 20 rods to the place of beginning. The Plat is laid out into five different lots, as more particularly shown on the Plat. The length and width of the lots have been marked on the Plat in chains and links an alley 11 feet wide was laid out along the said Road between the same and Lot No 3 on the N. W. side of it.
