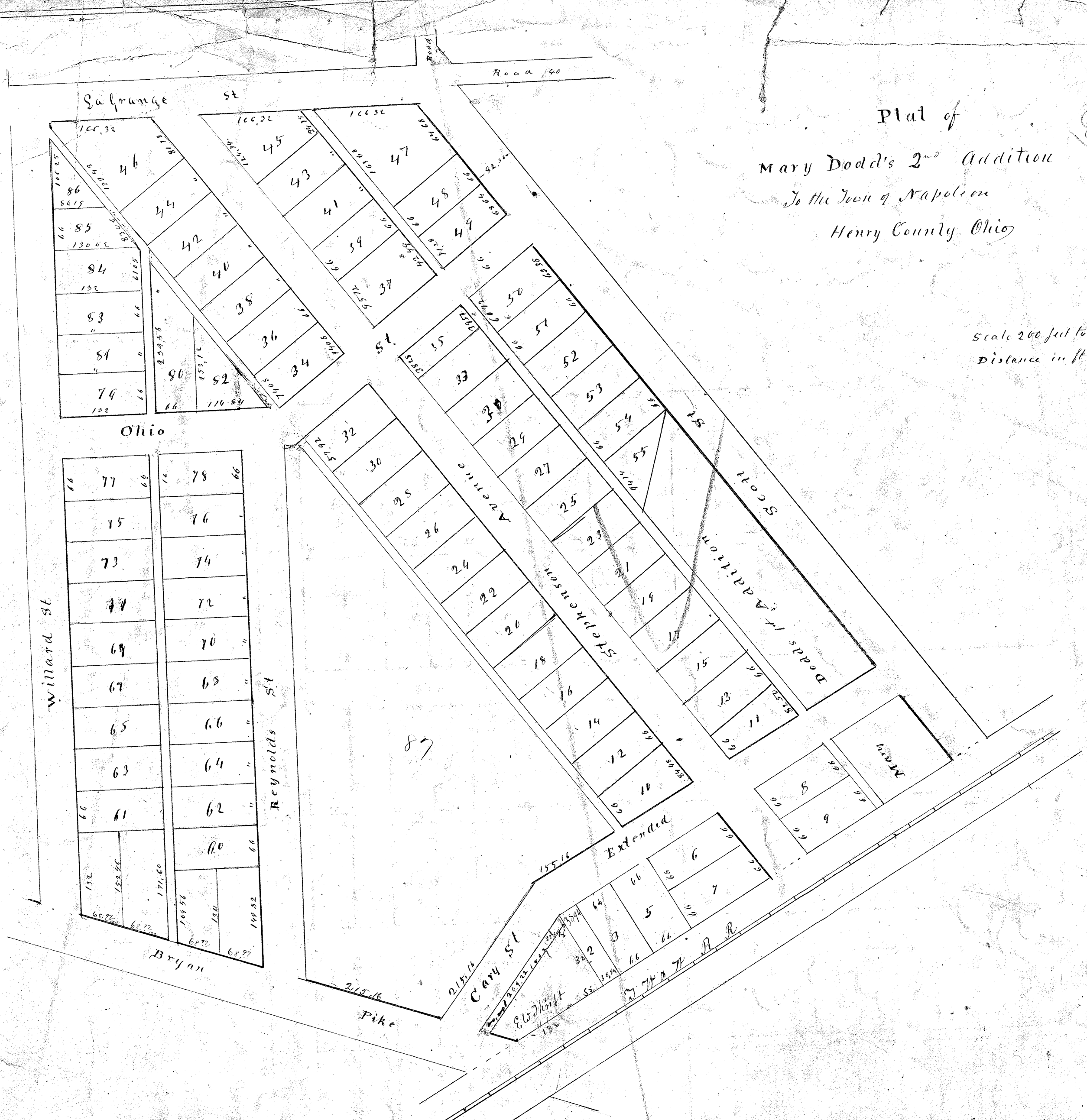




Plat of

Town 5 North Range 6 E. commencing 56 rods south and 20 feet east of the corner of sections 11, 12, 13 & 14. thence south 12 7/8, 28 feet thence
south 73° East 70 1/2, 58 ft; thence North 41 1/4 East 196.02 feet; thence South 23 1/4 East 109.26 ft; thence North 61° East 579.42 feet
thence North 37° West 615.12; thence North 18 1/4 East 182.02 ft; thence North 38° West 592 1/2 ft; thence North 30 feet to the place of
beginning. containing 31.66 subdivided as shown by this Plat Geo. C. Helstead Surveyor. April 20th 1872
