

Notice of Annexation

To whom it may concern.

Notice is hereby given that on the 3^d day of September, A.D. 1889, a petition was filed with the Commissioners of the County of Henry, and State of Ohio, the substance of which is: That on the 20th day of August, A.D. 1889, the Council of said Village passed an Ordinance authorizing the following described territory situated in the County of Henry, and State of Ohio, to wit: The south half of the south east quarter of Section thirty five (35), the south half of the south west quarter of the south east quarter of Section thirty six (36), all in Township four (4), north Range six (6) east. Also the north half of the south east quarter of Section two (2), Township three (3), north Range six (6) east to be annexed to the Incorporated Village of Holgate, Henry County, Ohio. That the said Ordinance, F.M. Rummell was appointed attorney for said Corporation to prosecute said annexation. Said petition will be for hearing by the Commissioners of said County at the Mayor's office in the Village of Holgate, Ohio, on the 12th day of November, A.D. 1889, at 10 o'clock A.M.

Commissioners Journal, Henry Co. Ohio, Special Session Nov 21st 1889.

Mayor's Office, Holgate, Henry Co. Ohio.

In the matter of annexation of Territory to the Incorporated Village of Holgate, Ohio. The Board of Commissioners of Henry Co. Ohio met this day at the Mayor's Office in the Village of Holgate, Henry Co. Ohio and were called to order by the President of the Board. The following motion was filed as follows: How comes Conrad Groll and Peter Ricker the owners of a portion of the territory sought to be annexed to said Incorporated Village and move your honorable body to dismiss the petition herein for the following reasons to wit: That no accurate map or plot of the territory sought to be annexed to said Incorporated Village of Holgate in this proceeding has been filed as required by statute in such proceedings. This motion was argued by counsel and the same was overruled and permission was granted that parties interested might be heard at Napoleon Ohio, Dec 16th 1889, on said matter by affidavit. Further proceedings herein were continued until Dec. 16th 1889 at 10 o'clock A.M. at Napoleon Ohio, at the Commissioners Office.
