

Petition for Annexation to McClure, Henry Co. Ohio.

McClure, Ohio. June 6th 1892.

To the Honorable board of Commissioners of Henry Co. Ohio

Gentlemen: We the undersigned adult residents and land owners residing within the herein described territory and accompanying map herewith presented do most humbly ask that said territory be annexed and made a part of the Incorporated Village of McClure Henry Co. Ohio. The description of said territory is as follows, viz: Commencing at a stone at the North west corner of the East one half (1/2) of the South East one quarter (1/4) Section number Twenty one (21) town five (5) North Range eight (8) East, thence East on the one half (1/2) section line of section twenty one (21) and twenty two (22) a distance of One Hundred and sixty (160) rods thence South through the center of the South west quarter (1/4) of section twenty two (22) and along the East line of the West one half (1/2) of the North west quarter (1/4) of section number twenty seven (27) a distance of two hundred and ninety (290) rods or to the North line of the Mansfield, Coldwater and Lake Michigan Railroad bed, thence North west along North line of said Railroad bed following the Incorporation line of the Village of McClure, Henry Co. Ohio, a distance of fifty three (53) rods and twelve (12) links thence North to a point in section twenty two (22) a distance of One Hundred and forty three (143) rods thence West to a point in section twenty one (21) a distance of fifty nine (59) rods and four (4) links, thence South eight (8) rods thence West forty (40) rods, thence following the Incorporation lines of the Village of McClure aforesaid thence North along the West line of the East one half (1/2) South East quarter (1/4) section number twenty one (21) to place of beginning. The foregoing described tract of land embraces the McClure Manufacturing and Machine Works Campau's patented addition not incorporated with adjacent territory being in County of Henry and State of Ohio. Commissioners Journal Henry County. Quarterly session June 7th 1892. In the matter of annexation of adjacent territory to the Village of McClure Ohio. (Petition filed June 6th 1892) Petition for the annexation of adjacent territory to the Village of McClure Henry Co. Ohio, was filed and presented to the board of Co. Commissioners of said County on the 6th day of June 1892. The Board caused the same to be placed on file in the Auditors Office and fixed the 19th day of July A.D. 1892 at 10 o'clock A.M. as the time and their office in Napoleon as the place for the hearing of said petition.

July 19th 1892. The Commissioners of Henry Co. Ohio met this day in special session at their office in Napoleon Ohio. Present A. J. Saggors, Presiding. In the matter of annexation of adjacent territory to the Village of McClure Ohio. 10 o'clock A.M. This being the day and hour fixed by the Commissioners of Henry Co. Ohio for the consideration of the above styled matter and the Board being fully advised in the premises do find that due notice and legal publication has not been given. It is now and therefor ordered that the Agent Frank O. Light be and he is hereby directed to give new notice according to Statute in such case made and provided, and that the time for the hearing on said petition be set for the 23rd day of Sept. A.D. 1892 at 10 o'clock A.M. J. H. Rish Co. Auditor.

Saggors and W. N. Zierolf. W. N. Zierolf Presiding. In the matter of the annexation of additional territory to the Village of McClure Henry Co. Ohio, and the Board being fully advised in the matter do find that due notice has been given both by publication and posting notices in the said Village of McClure Henry Co. Ohio. We therefor make our finding as follows. Of that part of the proposed annexation which lies North of the Village of McClure we hereby annex only as much as lies East of a straight line drawn from the West side of Main St North to the North side of the proposed annexation. Also all that part of the proposed annexation which lies North of a straight line drawn East from the South side of Chase Street in said Village east to the East line of this proposed annexation. J.
