Field Notes to John Knapes First Addition to Napoleon, O.

This addition is situated in the North West quarter of Section No 13 Town 5 North Range 6 East Henry County Ohio. Described as follows, Being a part of the North part of Lot No 20 and the South West part of Lot No 25 of Plot No 2, of Phillips and Staffords Addition to the Town of Napoleon as Recorded in Plot Book No 1 and on page No 16 in Records Office, also a tract of land beginning 20 feet East of the North East corner of Lot No 12 in Ed Dadds first Addition to the Town of Napoleon. Thence East 313 feet thence South to the North line of the Wabash Railroad, thence South westerly along the North line of said Railroad to within 20 feet of the East line of Lot No 1, in said Ed Dadds Addition thence North to the place of beginning containing 7.16 acres of land more or less.

Explanation

The Lots are numbered in red ink from 1 to 17 Dimensions of the lots are indicated in black in or boundary lines in feet and tenths Widths of streets and alleys are also given in black ink. Streets are named as shown on plat.
