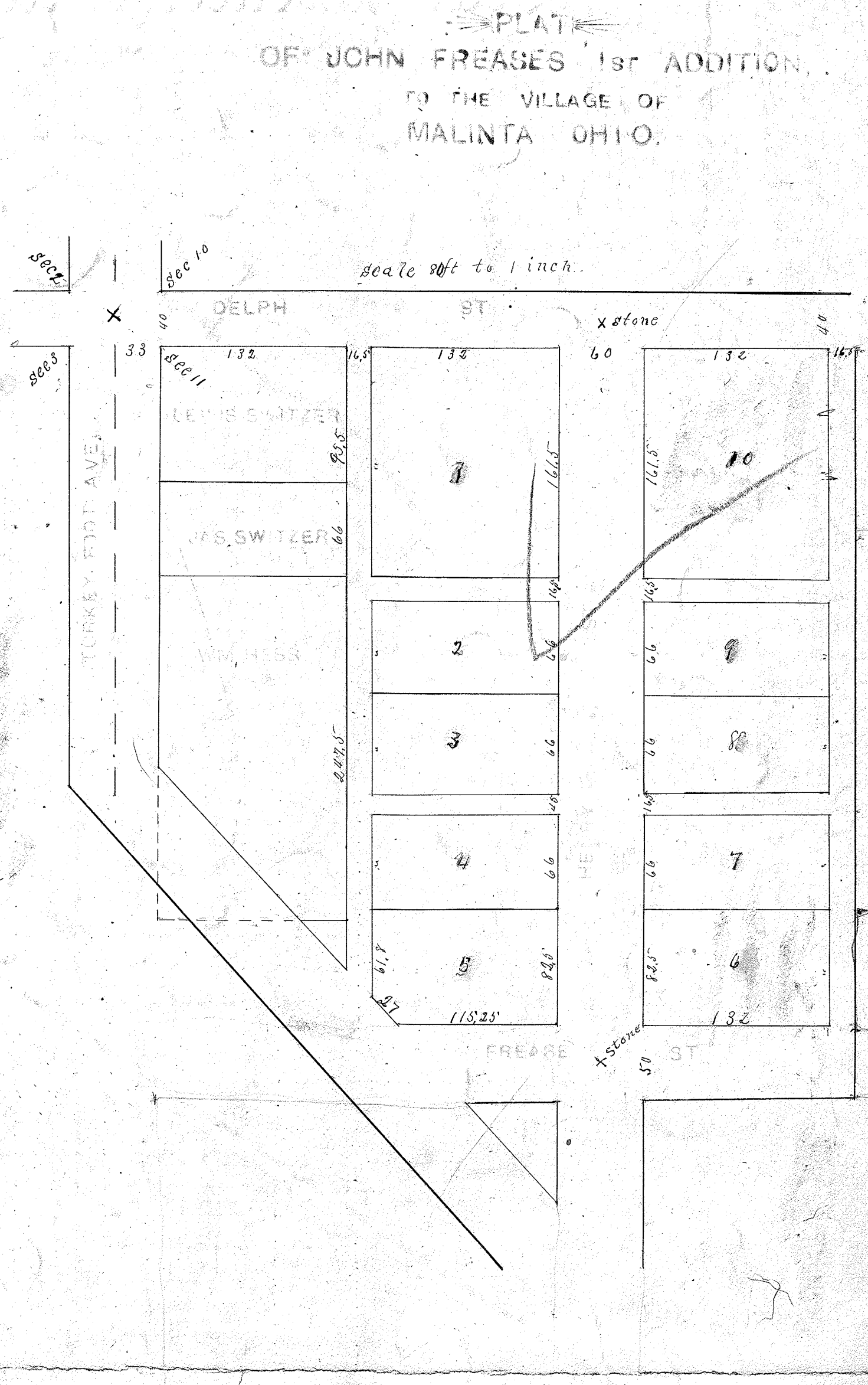

O. as shown on Plat of said addition. The Lots are numbered in red ink from 1 to 10. The dimensions of the Lots are indicated in black ink in feet & decimals of a foot. The width of the Street and alleys are also made in black ink. Surveyed April 15-1898.

Field Notes
Being a part of the North West Corner of the West half of the North West quarter (44) of Sec No Twenty Seven (27) Town five (5) North Range Eight (8) East Henry Co. Ohio and lying immediately South of David Goltz. First addition to the Village of "McClure" bounded and described as follows Commencing at the South West corner of said addition above and on the section line North & South between Sec No 27 & 28 and 370 1/2 feet South of the North West corner of said Sec No 27. Thence South along said section line between Sec. Nos 27 & 28 a distance of Eight Hundred Twenty Nine 1/2 feet (829 1/2) ft. Thence East a distance of Three Hundred Seventy 1/2 feet (370 1/2) ft. Thence North a distance of Eight Hundred Twenty Nine 1/2 feet (829 1/2) ft. Thence West a distance of Three Hundred Seventy 1/2 feet (370 1/2) ft. to place of beginning and containing Seven and 2/10 acres including Lots streets & alleys of above addition to the Village of "McClure".
