Commencing at a point 638.22 feet west and
165.5 feet south of the north east corner of section
fourteen (14) Town 5, North Range 6, East Henry
County Ohio, thence north 73 degrees west along
the north line of Woodlawn Ave 631.1 feet
to the quarter section line, thence north along
the quarter section line 148.72 feet, thence south
73 degrees east parallel with Woodlawn Ave
631.1 feet to Willard Street, thence south along
the west line of Willard Street 148.72 feet
to the place of beginning containing 2.07
acres of land, sub divided as shown on
plat, also the full width of Sheffield Ave.
4 rods extended back from Woodlawn Ave.
sixteen (16) rods in a north easterly
direction as indicated on plat.
