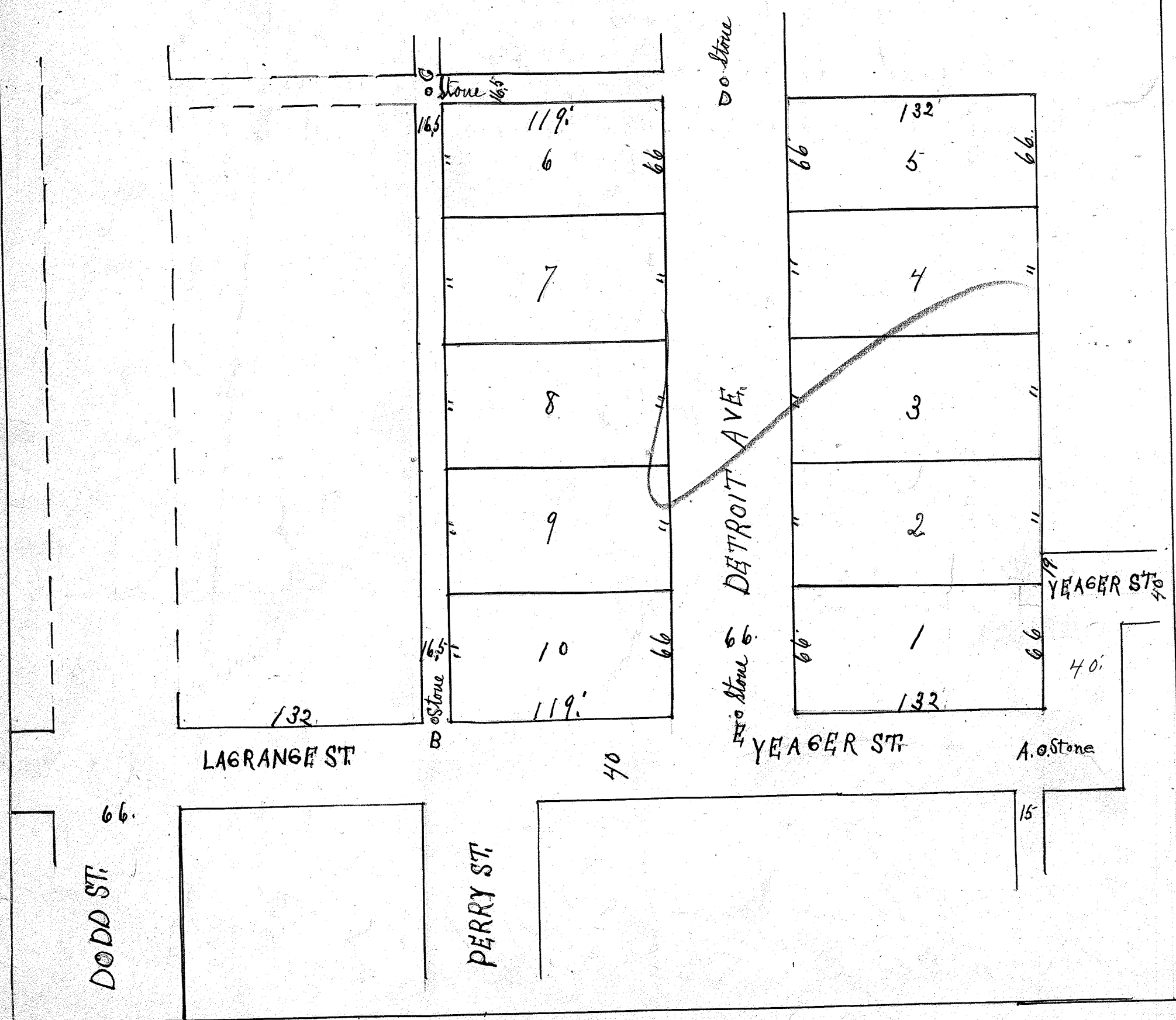


PLAT

OF WILLIAM M. YEAGER'S 1ST ADDITION,
TO THE VILLAGE OF NAPOLEON OHIO.



Field Note to William M. Yeager's first addition to the Village of Napoleon, Henry Co., O.
This plat is the southeast part of the north part of the west-half of the Northwest quarter of Section (No 13) Thirteen, Town Five (5) North, Range Six (6) East Henry County. This, bounded and described as follows to wit:-
Commencing at the north line of Yeager street in the Village of Napoleon Ohio, and on the line between the east-half and the west-half of the Northwest quarter of Section number Thirteen aforesaid, and running thence north along said quarter section line, which is also the west line of out lot No. 32, in Phillips and Staffords out lots, a distance of 330 feet, thence west 132 feet, thence north 16.5 feet, thence west 201.5 feet thence south 346.5 feet, to the north line of Yeager Street thence east along said line of Yeager Street 333.5 feet to the place of beginning, containing 2.583 acres of land,
Stones have been planted at points marked B, C, D, E, & F the place marked A is an old corner stone previously planted and recorded, the numbers and dimensions of lots and widths of streets and alleys have been shown on the plat in feet.
