Commencing 66 feet south and 33 feet east of an iron pin in the center of Upton street and the north side of William street, in the Village of Holgate, O.; thence east along south side of William street 488 feet; thence south 162 feet; thence west 488 feet to the east side of Upton Street; thence north 162 feet to place of beginning and sub-divided as shown on plat. The parcels along east side of lot 69, were previously sold as shown on plat but were not surveyed at this time.
