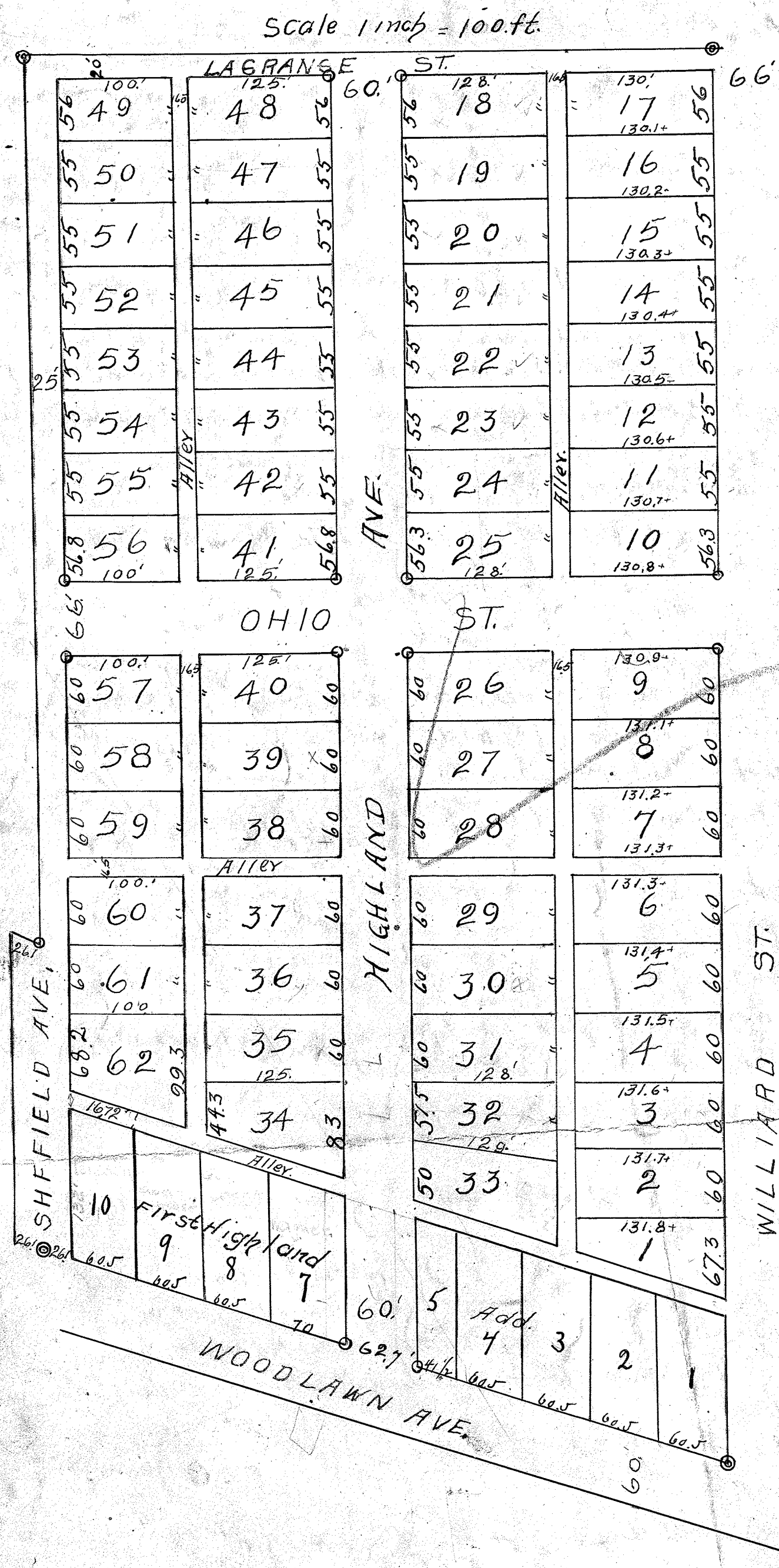


PLAT OF
SECOND HIGHLAND ADDITION
TO THE VILLAGE OF NAPOLEON HENRY Co.
OHIO.



Field Notes to the Second Highland Addition to the Village of Napoleon,
Henry County, Ohio.

Commencing at a point 658.22 feet West and 2165.5 feet South of the North-east corner of Section Fourteen (14) Town 5 North, Range 6 East, Henry County, Ohio, thence North 73 degrees West along the North line of Woodlawn Ave. 631.1 feet to the quarter (1/4) Section line, thence North along 1/4 Sec. line 1054 feet; thence East (at an angle of 90° 22') 601 feet, thence South along West line of Williard Street 1241.5 feet to place of beginning, less and except the South 148.72 feet strip formerly platted as Miller & Dornelly's Highland Addition. The dimensions of all lots, streets and alleys are shown on the plat, as are the numbers of all lots. The four corners of above plat are marked with concrete posts thus ©, while all street intersections are marked with iron pins thus ©.
