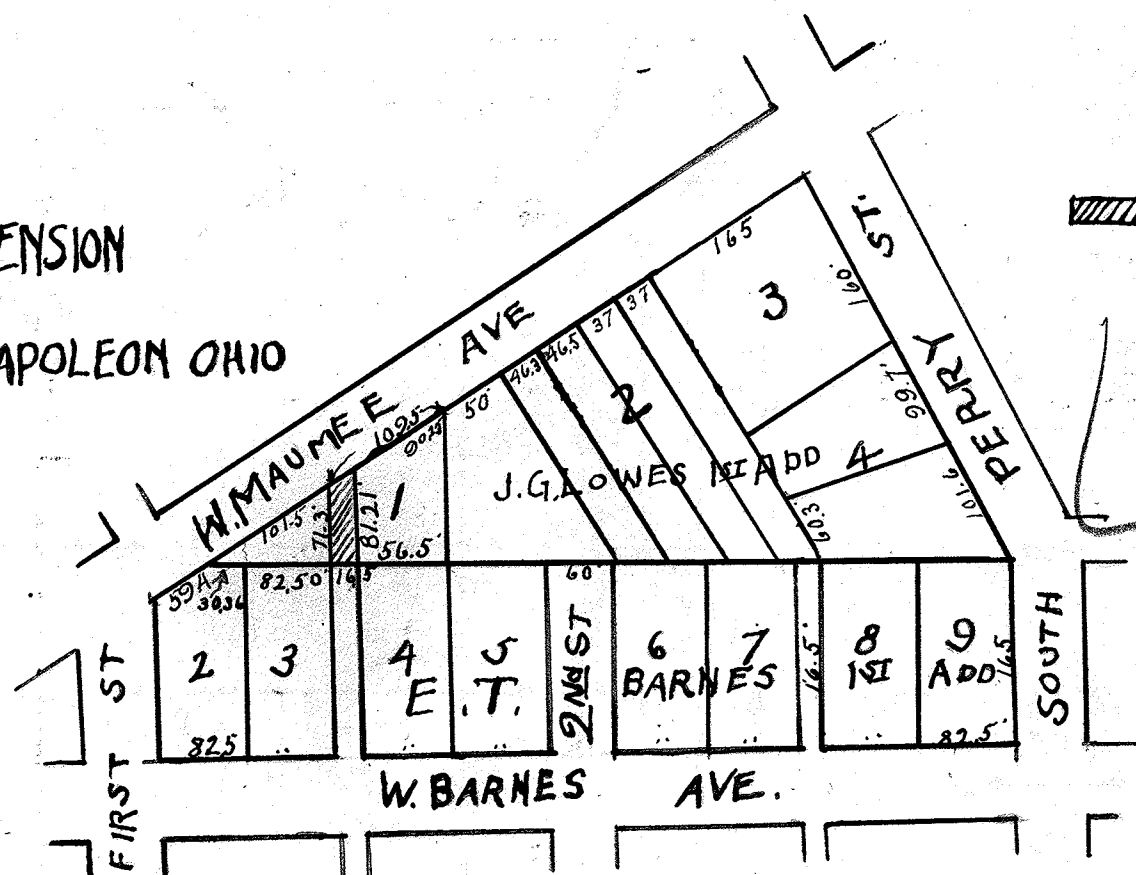


PLAT OF
